#### SUMMARY OF THE CHAIRMAN'S ANNUAL REPORT

In his Annual Report for 2013/14 the Chairman, Councillor John Peebles highlighted community activities such as the Love Where You Live event in Betty Eastwood Park in July 2013. Organised by Wakefield Council in conjunction with the Parish Council, it was well attended in spite of some dreadful weather. Here the award of a grant of £5,664 from the Big Lottery Fund was announced: this grant allowed the upgrading of 1.3 kilometres of footpaths in the Park using recycled materials.

He praised Hall Green Community Association's community spirit both for the gala they organised in conjunction with the Hall Green Sports Club and the switching on of the Christmas tree lights at Hall Green. This was a tremendous event with brilliant carol singing from the Dane Royd School Choir.

The Chairman was pleased that the Parish Council's hanging baskets had attracted a lot of compliments and he congratulated Newmillerdam Community &

Conservation Association who were awarded Gold in the Yorkshire in Bloom in July. He also noted the success of the Parish Council and residents on Hollingthorpe Lane in pressurising Wakefield Council to alleviate flooding problems there over recent years.

In November, Members were sorry to hear of the death of Mike Tivenan, a member of the Parks and Open Spaces Committee. In recognition of his great work in the Park, a bench with a commemorative plaque was to be installed in the Park.

The Chairman mentioned grant awards in the year to the Calder Grove/Durkar Fundraisers for Wakefield Hospice, the Friends of Betty Eastwood Park and Hall Green Chair Exercise Group; and the Community Hero Award 2013 which was presented to Kevan Norbury with Tony Betts and Christine Platten as runners up.
