Crimes:

Chapelthorpe

There was a report of damage from an address on Hall Lane. No suspect/s have been identified and this crime has been filed.

Calder Grove

At one address on Grove Park there were four separate crime reports. The ultimate crime was serious assault which is still being investigated. The other crimes was harassment related.

Also on Grove Park there was a report of a public order incident. This is still being investigated.

Hall Green

On Hollingthorpe Road there was a report of a theft of scrap metal. No suspect/s have been identified and this has been filed.

On Moorside Crescent there was a report of a theft from a vehicle. A sat nav and cash were stolen. No suspect/s have been identified and this crime has been filed.

On Low Moor Crescent there was a report of a malicious communication which is domestic related. The victim did not wish to pursue the matter and so the crime has been filed.

On Copeworth Drive there was a report of a domestic related criminal damage where a door was broken. This is still under investigation.

There was a report of a domestic theft. The victim declined to prosecute the victim and so the crime has been filed.

On Micklethwaite Road there was a report of an attempted burglary where a garage was damaged. No entry was gained and the suspect/s made off. They have not been identified and this has been filed.

On Marshall Avenue there were two reports of neglect of children. The children have been removed and the crimes are still under investigation.

On Low Moor Crescent there were two linked reports of assaults where the involved parties are neighbours. These crimes are still being investigated.

Durkar

At an address on Denby Dale Road someone reported that there were being harassed by an ex-partner. They then did not wish to go to court and so the crime was filed.

There was a report of an attempt burglary dwelling at an address on Howard Crescent. The suspect kicked the door and tried the handle, but did not gain entry. They were not identified and this has been filed.

There was also a report of a burglary on Howard Crescent involving a known suspect. This crime is still under investigation.

On Orchard Gardens there was a report of a theft from motor vehicle. Sunglasses and cash was stolen. No suspect/s have been identified and this crime has been filed.

On Denby Dale Road there has been a vehicle interference. Nothing was stolen from the vehicle. No suspect/s have been identified and this crime has been filed.

There was a report of theft of lead from an address on The Close. No suspect has been identified and this has been filed.

At an address on Durkar Fields there was a report of damage to a dwelling. No suspect was identified and this crime has been filed.

There was also a report of a public order offence involving neighbours. This is still being investigated.

There was a report of a make off from the Grange Service Station where someone has not paid for some fuel. No suspect/s have been identified for this crime and it was been filed.

There was a theft from motor vehicle at the Premier Inn. This is still being investigated.

Crigglestone

On Common Way there was a report of a domestic related assault. The suspect was given a conditional caution.

A motor bike was stolen from High Street. The crime is still being investigated.

At Garden Terrace there were two reports of public order offences involving neighbours. The suspects were interviewed, but there was not enough evidence to prosecute anyone so the crimes were filed.

At St James School there was a report of a wooden gate being damaged. No suspect/s were identified and this has been filed.

On St James Road there was a report of an assault involving their partner's ex. This is still being investigated.

There was a report of revenge porn from an address on Woodmoor Close. This is still being investigated.

At a shop on Painthorpe Lane there was a report of a public order offence. The suspect was identified, but the victim declined to prosecute so the crime was filed.

Newmillerdam

No reported crime.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

There were a total of eleven ASB related calls made in February.

Of these seven reports of flytipping. These were on Durkar Low Lane (x 2), Denby Dale Road East, Daw Lane (x 2), Broadcut Road and Hollingthorpe Lane.

On Asdale Road three motorbikes were found on fire. None of these were reported as stolen.

On Denby Dale Road, Durkar there was a report of two youths throwing an old chair into a garden and running off.

There was a report of a nuisance monkey bike on St James Way.

There was a report of youths throwing stones at cars on South View, Crigglestone.

PC 6319 reports:

02/02/16 between 1830 x 0130

Tried to contact the cllr Platten to no gain, covering speeding issues on Cliff Rd, Denby Dale rd, Painthorpe Lane, Barnsley Rd, near St Pierre, x6 tor issued, x4 verbal warnings for being within parameter. X 2 vdrs, warning advice given. Patrols of the village and all areas all in order.

1x vehicle white transit van failed to stop for NPT officers, this was pursued and this vehicle rammed the police vehicle, this vehicle headed towards Newmillerdam/Barnsley Rd area, area search made to no gain. Patrols of Betty eastwood park, no issues, general hi vis patrols in the area.

PCSO 438 reports:

04/02/2016 between 1600 x 1800

Safe Scheme carried out between 1600hrs and 1800hrs on 04/02/16. Areas patrolled were the Betty Eastwood Park, Daw Green Avenue and Hollin Lane Junction with Denby Dale Road for parking offences. In all areas there was nothing to note.

PCSO 438 Reports:

14/02/2016 between 1500 x 1800

Safe Scheme carried out between 1500 and 1800hrs on Sunday 14/02/16. Areas patrolled were the Betty Eastwood Park nothing to note, Daw Green Avenue nothing to note. 1x FPN ticket was issued on Denby Dale Road outside the Kingfisher fish n chip shop for a car which was parked on double yellow lines. General patrols of the area were also carried out.

On Thursday 18th February I worked 2 hours on this Safe scheme (2000 x 2200). Phoned and spoke with Cllr Platten at commencement of tour and made aware where working. Concentrated on speeding issues on Hollin Lane and Denby Dale Road at Calder Grove and Durkar. No success from time spent on Hollin Lane but 6 x Traffic offence reports submitted re excess speed on Denby Dale Road.

22/02/2016 between 2100 x 0400

Worked crigg safe 2100x0400 – 22/2/16, covered the areas pro-active patrols all highlighted areas, due to recent thefts and motor vehicle crime in the area. X 6 t.o.r issued re speeding offences on Denby Dale Rd, x3 motorists issued with warnings re. speed excess 30. X2 motorists given warning re VDRS advice. Other areas patrolled and the main focus of the shift was pro-active patrols late night patrols as requested by supv.

28/02/2016 between 1800x 2100

On Sunday 28th February I worked 3 hours on this Safe scheme (1800 x 2100). Phoned and spoke with Cllr Platten at commencement of tour. Tour spent on Denby Dale Road at Durkar and Calder Grove re speeding issues and in particular "boy racers" entering and leaving Wakefield with it being Sunday evening. 7 x Traffic offence reports were submitted re excess speed, most offenders from Huddersfield. 2 x further motorists stopped and verbally warned.
