Crimes:

In January there was a total of 34 reported crimes.

CHAPELTHORPE

No crime.

NEWMILLERDAM

On School Hill there was a report of an exposure involving a taxi driver asking a fare to engage in sexual activity with them when they could not pay. This crime is still under investigation.

Also on School Hill there was a report of a burglary other than a dwelling where a garage was broken into and an air rifle was stolen. All lines of enquiry are now complete and the crime has been filed.

On Barnsley Road there was a report of a criminal damage caused to a wall. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

There was a report of a burglary on Mill Farm Drive where entry was gained by the suspects via a window that had been forced open. Various items were stolen including jewellery and money. The investigation is still ongoing.

At the industrial park there was a report of a theft of diesel from some plant machinery. No suspects have been identified and the investigation is complete so the crime has been filed.

CALDER GROVE

At an address on Denby Dale road there was a report of an attempted burglary other than a dwelling where the suspect has driven into the cellar doors to try and gain access, but failed. The suspects have not been identified and the crime has been filed.

There was a report of a criminal damage at an address on Sandpiper Road. The crime was domestic related and the victim declined to prosecute the suspect. There was not enough evidence to proceed so the crime has been filed.

DURKAR

At an address on Hollin Drive there was a report of a burglary where the suspect/s have entered through an insecure side door and taken a handbag. No suspects were identified and the crime has been filed.

Also on Hollin Drive was a report of a theft from motor vehicle where a window was smashed to gain access. No suspects have been identified and this has been filed.

On Durkar Lane there was a report of a damage to motor vehicle that was parked on the road. No suspects have been identified and all of the lines of enquiry have been completed so the crime has been filed.

At the Premier Inn there was a report of a domestic assault that occurred between guests. The crime is still under investigation.

CRIGGLESTONE

At Mackie Hill Close there was a report of a public order incident between neighbours regarding parking. The caller declined to prosecute the suspect so the crime was filed.

There was a report of a malicious communication at Garden Terrace which involved comments being made on Facebook. The suspect could not be identified and the victim declined to take it any further so the crime has been filed.

Also on Garden Terrace was a report of a threats to kill. This crime is domestic related and the investigation is still ongoing.

On Daw Green Avenue there were to crimes of assaulting a constable that occurred at the same time. The suspect was arrested a charged for the offences.

There was also a report of a damage to motor vehicle on Daw Green Avenue. The suspect was arrested and given a conditional caution.

At one address on Common Way there was a report of two assault that occurred between family members. The suspect was arrested, but there was insufficient evidence to charge the suspect and he was released without charge.

At another address on Common Way there was a reported burglary dwelling where the suspect was a family member. The victim declined to prosecute the suspect and the crime has been filed.

Also on Common Way was a report of damage to motor vehicle where a tyre was punctured. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified so the crime has been filed.

On Painthorpe Lane there was a report of a theft from shop where the suspect has stolen some wine. The suspect was arrested and charged with the offence.

At an address on High Street there was a report of a burglary. The address was uninhabited and nothing is believed to have been stolen. The address next door was also broken into and two rings were stolen. The investigation is still ongoing into these two crimes.

There was a report of damage being caused to gates at a business property on the industrial park. The crime is still being investigated.

Also on High Street there was a report a vehicle interference where an unknown suspect has caused damage to a lock, but not managed to gain entry. All lines of enquiry are now complete and the crime has been filed.

On Painthorpe Terrace there was a report of a domestic assault between a father and son. The suspect was arrested, but was later released without charge as there was not enough evidence to prosecute.

At an address on West View there was a reported damage to motor vehicle where a tyre has been puncture. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

There was a further report of a vehicle being damaged on Dennington Lane. The window of this vehicle was smashed. The suspect/s made off without being seen and there are no further lines of enquiry so the crime has been filed.

HALL GREEN

There was one report of a malicious communication on Micklethwaite Road, but the victim did not support a prosecution so the crime was filed.

On Stoney Lane there was a report of some damage caused to a car. The tyres of the vehicle was punctured. No suspects have been identified and all of the lines of enquiry are complete. This crime has been filed.

On Painthorpe Lane there was also a report of damage to a car where a gate was thrown onto the roof. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

On Hollingthorpe Grove there was a report of a blackmail involving Facebook where the victim engaged in sexual activity and sent images of this to someone who then tried to extort money out of the victim to stop said images becoming public. The investigation is complete and no suspect has been identified.

On Hollingthorpe Road there was a report of a burglary where the suspects have gained entry by smashing a window. From the address was stolen a pressure washer and some medals. The investigation is still ongoing.

There was another report of threats to kill, this time on Moorland Drive. This was domestic related where the victim declined to prosecute there suspect. There was not enough evidence to proceed so the crime was filed.

There was a report of a burglary at an address on Copeworth Drive. The victim has come downstairs and found the suspect inside the house. The suspect has made off and the victim has declined to prosecute. This crime has been filed.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Officer Activity:

PCSO 438 Reports:

03/01/16 between 1500 x 1800

Safe Scheme carried out between 1500 and 1800hrs on Sunday 03/01/16. Areas patrolled were the Betty Eastwood Park, Daw Green Avenue and the junction of Hollin Lane and Denby Dale Road. There were no offences and nothing to note in any of the locations visited.

PC 6319 reports:

08/01/16 between 0930 x 1630

Worked safe, crigg, 8/1/16, 0930x1630 x7 T.O.R issued on Cliff Rd, x5 T.o.r warning advice notes issued, x5 Hort/1 checks, and 1x vdrs warning advice given. Also patrolled Hollin Lane and near Kingfisher, x1 ticket issued for parking on double yellow lines, and one male warned as I approached he was going to park.

X 2 vehicles HGV were about to turn onto Hollin Lane, but did not on seeing me, wanted advice on how to get onto the ind estate on High St.

General patrols, Betty Eastwood Park conducted, hi-vis foot, all in order, no issues

PC 863 reports:

16/01/16 between 1300 x 1600

On Saturday 16th January I worked 3 hours on this scheme (1300 x 1600). Concentrating on speeding issues in the Parish Phoned Cllr Platten at commencement of tour but no answer. First hour spent Cliff Road and Painthorpe Lane. Just 1 warning on each road..2 x sets of roadworks on Cliff Road had effect of slowing any vehicles down. Moved down to Durkar Lane opposite St James Way re vehicles travelling Crigglestone bound. 4 x Traffic offence reports submitted and 1 x vehicle defect form...For last 45 minutes moved down to Denby Dale Road Calder Grove.....4 x Traffic offence reports submitted re exceed 30 mph.

PC 863 reports:

17/01/16 between 1200 x 1500

On Sunday 17th January I worked 3 hours on this Safe scheme (1200 x 1500). Spoke at commencement of tour with Cllr Platten. No new concerns. Tour affected by some snow still on minor roads which has natural effect of slowing vehicles down...concentrated on Denby Dale Road at Durkar and Calder Grove.....10 x Traffic offence reports submitted re excess speed to motorists.

PC 3051 reports:

20/01/16 between 1600 x 1800

Patrols conducted in line with the priorities around Daw Green Avenue and Woodmoor regarding ASB. Three youths spoken to on Daw Green. No concerns. Speed checks completed on Barnsley Road with three verbal warnings issued.

PC 547 reports:

20/01/16 between 1500 x 1700

Patrols conducted around Betty Eastwood Park. No problems during this time. Also further checks made at the Kingfisher where two vehicles were advised regarding their parking. No other issues were identified during this tour of duty.

PC 6323 reports:

22/01/16 between 0000 x 0200

Proactive patrols conducted around the Crigglestone Parish as directed in the company of PC 3789. Two suspicious vehicles stopped, one on Fishponds Lane and another on Durkar Lane. Nothing to report. One person stopped out on foot. Checks completed and no issues identified.

PC 863 reports:

24/01/16 between 1800 x 2100

On Sunday 24th January I worked 3 hours on this Parish scheme (1800 x 2100). Phoned Cllr Platten at commencement of tour but no answer. Owing to Sunday evening "boy racer" problems vehicles making their way into and exiting Wakefield on Denby Dale Road spent majority of tour on that road at Calder Grove and Durkar. A total of 8 x Traffic offence reports were submitted re speeding offenders and later 2 motorists warned on Durkar Lane.

PC 3051 reports:

26/01/16 between 0000 x 0300

Myself and 3494 conducted proactive patrols in the Crigglestone Parish covering all areas. During this time we stopped three vehicles, one of which was sighted on St James Way and had intelligence linked to it for drugs. Another vehicle was sighted on Barker's Road and made off at speed before we were able to stop it. During this time one of the occupants off loaded a dark blue gillet Durkar Lane. This has been recovered and enquiries are ongoing. One person also stopped on foot on Church Lane. There was nothing suspicious as he had just finished his shift at Aldi stacking shelves.
