

Priority Patrols:

Parking on Stoney Lane near the Co-op and on Wood Lane near the terraces houses.
Speeding on Durkar Low Lane, Cliff Road and High Street.
Off-road bikes near Painthorpe,

Crimes:

Chapelthorpe

No reported crime.

Calder Grove

A theft of rabbit hutch occurred at an address on Hollin Lane. The suspect was interviewed but no further action was taken.

A guest's laptop was stolen from their room at Cedar Court. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

Some timber fencing was stolen from land near to Denby Dale Road. There were no lines of enquiry and the crime has been filed.

A gas reader was stolen from an employee working on Denby Dale Road. The suspect was not seen and there were no lines of enquiry so the crime has been filed.

Hall Green

A house was burgled on Edgemoor Road. The suspect has forced a front window and stole various items including a watch and iPod. The investigation is still ongoing.

A theft in a dwelling was reported at an address on Moorland Drive where a key was stolen from a handbag. The suspect was dealt with and no further action was taken.

There was a burglary at an address on Hollingthorpe Lane. The suspect was disturbed by the occupants and nothing was stolen. This is still under investigation.

A public order offence was reported on Russell Avenue. The victim declined to prosecute the suspect so the crime has been filed.

Durkar

A malicious communication was received at an address on Durkar Lane. The suspect was identified, but the victim declined to prosecute so no further action was taken.

Two addresses on Hollin Drive had lead flashing stolen from windows. No suspects have been identified and the crimes have been filed.

Another address on Colleen Drive was attacked for lead flashing, but the suspects were unsuccessful on this occasion. The crime has been filed.

A damage was reported at an address on Durkar Low Lane. The suspect was a neighbour of the victim, but the victim declined to prosecute so no further action was taken. The suspect made a counter allegation of assault, but also declined to prosecute so no further action was taken.

A dwelling on Newland Crescent was broken into where the suspects have smashed a rear window. It is not believed that anything was stolen, but the investigation is still ongoing.

There were two vehicles broken into belonging to guests staying at the Premier Inn. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crimes filed.

An assault was reported at Premier Inn by a member of staff. This is still under investigation. A counter allegation was made at the same time of rape, but this was proved to be false and so no further action was taken.

A make off without payment was reported at BP, Calder Park. The suspect later returned to pay the monies owed. There was also a second where no suspect has been identified and the crime has been filed.

A domestic related malicious communication was reported on Denby Dale Road. The suspect was given a conditional caution.

Three males were involved in an attempt to steal lead flashing from an address on The Crimbles. The suspects were disturbed and have not been identified.

There was a make off without payment reported at the petrol station on Denby Dale Road. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

There was a report of a malicious communication on Maybury Avenue. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

Crigglestone

An attempted burglary occurred at a house on Oarkhall Park. The occupant has disturbed three people as they attempted to break in through the back door. The suspects have made off in a vehicle. This crime is still under investigation.

A malicious communication was reported by the resident of a property on West View. The suspect was interviewed but there was insufficient evidence to charge them.

A domestic related assault was reported at an address on Daw Green Avenue. The suspect was arrested and charged with the offence.

A vehicle was damaged on Daw Green Avenue. This is still under investigation.

Again on Daw Green Avenue there was a report of a public order offence. This is still under investigation.

A report was made of a lamppost being damaged on Hollin Lane. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

Two counter allegations of public order offences were reported by residents on Daw Green Avenue. They are both still under investigation.

A bungalow on Bull Lane was the location of an attempted burglary. The suspects have tried and failed to force a window and have made off without gaining entry. This crime is still under investigation.

An insecure vehicle was broken into on Oarkhall Park and an iPod stolen. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

There was a report from a resident on Daw Green Avenue stating that they had heard someone threaten to damage their property. The suspect was never seen and the crime has been filed.

A make off without payment was reported on High Street where a suspect has run from a taxi. They have not been identified and the crime has been filed.

A domestic related harassment was reported on Cliff Road. This is still under investigation.

A dangerous dog was reported at an address on Garden Terrace. The crime is still under investigation.

A motorbike was stolen from an address on High Street. It was recovered on Portobello, but no suspects were identified. The crime has been filed.

A vehicle interference was reported on Woodhall Close where the rear lock was damaged, but nothing stolen. The crime has been filed.

There was a report of an assault on Painthorpe Lane where the victim has been working at a property and been assaulted by an unknown male. All lines of enquiry are complete and the suspect has not been identified.

During the same incident windows in the property were smashed. This crime has also been filed.

There was a report of a domestic related assault on Aberfield Drive. The crime is still under investigation.

There was a domestic related assault on Garden Terrace between a parent and child. The victim declined to prosecute the suspect and the crime has been filed.

There was a domestic related harassment reported at an address on Fishponds Drive. The investigation is still ongoing.

There was a public order incident reported on Woodmoor Rise. The suspect was arrested and given a conditional caution.

Newmillerdam

A vehicle was damaged whilst at Newmillerdam County Park. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

Another vehicle was attacked and property stolen in the car park of the Hotel St Pierre. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

Workmen reported that their vehicle was shot at with a pellet gun while they were working on Barnsley Road. No suspects have been identified and the crime has been filed.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

There was a report of a suspicious van seen on Hollin Lane. This matched the description for the thefts so it has been submitted for further enquiries. There were three other reports of similar nature in Durkar.

A male was seen on The Links trying car door handles.

Another was seen on The Crimbles doing the same.

A bag of bones was seen near the Station Pub. These were examined and found to be horse bones.

There were three reports of flytipping on Painthorpe Lane, Castle Meadows, two on Barnsley Road and another on Durkar Low Lane.

There was a report of nuisance youths throwing water balloons on Daw Green Avenue.
On Garden Terrace some of the youths were smashing up wood in the street.
Some others were seen on Kenton Drive, drinking and smoking.
There was a report of a nuisance bike on Durkar Fields.

Pc 863 Laybourne reports:

On Friday the 15th April I worked 3 hours on this Safe scheme (1300 x 1600) Spoke at commencement of tour with Cllr Platten. Made aware of vehicle parked on pavement/obstruction High Street.
