Crimes:

Chapelthorpe

In Chapelthorpe there have been no reported crimes in August.

Calder Grove

In Calder Grove there were three reported crime, one of which was a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft from motor vehicle on Hollin Lane where the vehicle has been left insecure and property was stolen. Some property was located nearby and returned to the owner, but no suspects have been identified.

The other crimes both occurred at Cedar Court Hotel and were a theft and a threat to commit criminal damage.

Hall Green

In Hall Green there were nine reported crimes of which one of these was a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft from motor vehicle on Castle Meadows. The vehicle was left insecure with a sat nav affixed to the window. There were no lines of enquiry and the crime has been filed.

The other crimes consisted of a damage to a vehicle, an assault and two public order offences on Russell Avenue, a theft from shop on Stoney Lane, a damage to property on Hollingthorpe Road, an assault on Painthorpe Lane, and a theft of phone on Marshall Avenue.

Durkar

In Durkar there were eight reported crimes of which three were serious acquisitive crimes.

There was a Burglary at Hampson's Plant World where suspects broke into staff lockers to steal car keys before stealing the car. The vehicle was recovered in Leeds and arrests have been made, but the investigation is still ongoing.

There were also two theft from motor vehicles on Peel Avenue at Mercedes and Audi. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified.

The other crimes consisted of two make off without payments from Grange Service Station, Denby Dale Road, a damage on Denby Dale Road, a public order offence on Calder Park, and a theft on Denby Dale Road East.

Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there were sixteen reported crimes of which three were serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a theft of motor vehicle from High Street, however the victim phoned back to say that they forgotten where they had left it and had found it.

There was also a theft from motor vehicle and an attempt theft from motor vehicle on High Street. For the attempt the suspect has been disturbed by the owner, and for the other no suspects have been identified.

The other crimes consisted of an assault on Fishponds Drive, an assault and criminal damage on Painthorpe Lane, an assault on Woodmoor Rise, an assault and two damages on Church View, an assault on High Street, possession of cannabis on Haveroid Lane, a malicious communication on Haveroid Way, and an assault, theft from person and possession of a firearm (CS incapacitant spray taken from a police officer).

Newmillerdam

In Newmillerdam there were two reported crimes of which both were serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a theft of motor vehicle which occurred at the country park where a motor cycle has been stolen.

The investigation into this is still on going. The second was a theft from motor vehicle that occurred on Wood Lane where a window of a van has been smashed and tools stolen from inside. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect has been identified.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

The ASB calls consisted off six nuisance bikes calls (Denby Dale Road, Durkar Lane and Durkar Low Lane), nuisance youths smashing glass in the woods off Slack Lane, a male and female selling door to door on Hollingthorpe Avenue, and three suspicious males looking into a garden on Howard Crescent.

I worked two hours 00:00 x 02:00 on Thursday 25th August, authorised by Inspector Chamberlain following several reports of nuisance youths on mopeds.

Following a conversation with a parish council member on the 24th i focused my patrols on the High Street / Fishponds Drive area of Crigglestone and Durkar Lane / The Close area of Durkar.

Two mopeds sighted individually however nothing of note from either. Assumed due to the seizure of one and disruption to the group from NPT the night before.

PC 638 reports:

Safe scheme worked on following dates:

23/08 - 23x02

24/08 - 23x02

25/08 - 00x02

Increase in calls around Crigglestone/Durkar areas re nuisance bikes. Extra patrols due to issues with bikes on the 23rd due to calls for nuisance bikes one bike was seized under S59 and one other given a S59 warning.

Further bikes sighted during other 2 nights however no VRMs obtained due to speed they were travelling at. Areas around Crigglestone/Durkar checked for bikes to no gain. Intelligence picture being built up by NPT of persistent offenders with action taken.

Alarm sounding at Durkar - checked and in order.

No other issues and no calls for service.

PCSO 500 Dickson reports:

x5 hrs S/S Crigglestone completed on the 31.08.16 between 17.00x22.00 FOOT PATROL

At approximatley 17.30hrs advice delivered to an address on Copeworth Drive in relation to camera equipment being left on show in their vehicle.

No answer to knocking.

18.30hrs -- Patrolled snicket between Stoney Lane / Hall Lane - No issues.

18.45hrs - Attended Chapelthorpe Church - Call for assistance - new vicar being introduced to the congregation

x200 parishners plus vehicles. Traffic issues monitored as requested.

At 19.20hrs above date whilst located in the Daw Green Avenue I witnessed a known male leave the above residential street and enter the main road that is Painthorpe Rd on their bike /alone crossing over to the shop.

They did not use any observations when he crossed the road and at the above time traffic was still frequent.

They were taken to their home address and a report made to social services.

20.30hrs - Whilst on Crigglestone High Street and outside the WMC I could smell a strong smell of cannabis.

The four person's present all denied having any controlled substance on their person/ or as having just used it.

Nothing to support a search but all were warned and I will be speaking with the owners/ staff to monitor their outside space.

Whilst on the High Street I observed x2 vehicles traveling at speeds I estimate to be between 30-60 mph and 1 high powered motorcycle doing the same and lifting its front wheel as it travelled. All going too fast for me to record VRM'S.
