Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were ASB use of vehicles, ASB in Betty Eastwood Park and speeding throughout the parish.

Crimes:

Calder Grove

In Calder Grove there were four report crimes, one of which was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft of a moped from the garden of an address on Hollin Lane. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other crime consisted of an assault on Denby Dale Road and two thefts at Cedar Lodge.

Chapelthorpe

There was one reported crime in Chapelthorpe which was not classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

The crime was a harassment at an address on Hall Lane.

Crigglestone

There were fourteen reported crime in Crigglestone of which one was classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

This was a vehicle interference on Dennington Lane where the rear window was damage on a vehicle, but no entry gained. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other crime consisted of a public order offence at an address on Fishponds Drive, two damages and three assaults on Painthorpe Lane, damage to a hedge on Hollin Lane, an assault, a damage and a malicious communication on Swallow Way, a malicious communication on Dennington Lane, an assault on Garden Terrace, and a theft on High Street.



Durkar

There were nineteen reported crimes in Durkar. Of these fifteen were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

There were nine reported burglary businesses at an address Denby Dale Road. Each crime related to a separately rented unit that had been broken into all at the same time. At this stage all of the enquiries have been completed and no suspects have been identified.

There was a burglary residential at an address on Howard Crescent where suspects have broken into the garage. The investigation is still ongoing at this time.

There was another burglary residential at an address on Denby Dale Road where suspects have gained entry via breaking the glass in the patio doors. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

There was a theft from motor vehicle on Denby Dale Road East where the registration plates have been stolen from a vehicle. No suspect/s have been identified.

There was a vehicle interference on The Crimbles where a car alarm was activated when suspects tried to gain entry. When the alarm sounded they made off. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been indentified.

There were two theft from motor vehicles on Maybury Avenue. In the first the suspect has smashed a window and removed property. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other crime consisted of a public order offence at an address on Denby Dale Road, a dog bite on Wadhouse Lane, a theft on Kenton Drive, and a damage on Fox Court.

Hall Green

There were two reported crimes in Hall Green. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a burglary residential at an address on Stoney Lane. Suspect/s have broken into the address by forcing the rear upvc door. Once inside they have used cleaning equipment to remove forensic opportunities and before leaving.

The other crime consisted of a threat to commit criminal damage at an address on Copeworth Drive.

Newmillerdam

There were two reported crime in Newmillerdam. Neither were classed as serious acquisitive crimes. This crimes were a harassment on Barnsley Road and a make off without payment from the Hotel St Pierre.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Calder Grove

There was one ASB related call in Calder Grove. This was a report of nuisance youths congregating on Broad Cut Road.

Chapelthorpe

There was one ASB related call in Chapelthorpe. This was a report of residents burning rubbish.

Crigglestone

There were six ASB related calls in Crigglestone. Of these three related to fly tipping on Swallow Way, Painthorpe Lane and Daw Lane. The rest related to nuisance youths in Betty Eastwood Park, youths causing damage in a garden on Hollin Lane and more youths throwing eggs at houses on Woodmoor Drive.

Durkar

There were two ASB related calls in Durkar. These were about youths throwing stones and fly tipping Durkar Low Lane.

Hall Green

There was one ASB related call in Hall Green which was about nuisance bikes off Grenville Walk.

Newmillerdam

There were three ASB related calls in Newmilerdam. These were nuisance bikes near Lake View, fly tipping on Wood Lane and an abusive motorist on Barnsley Road
