Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were;

Denby Dale Rd – Boy races and HGV parking in bus stops Betty Eastwood Park – Nuisance Youths

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There were 5 reported crimes in Calder Grove, one was an attempt burglary on Sandpiper Lane where the offenders were disturbed, the other four are not seen to impact on the community.

Chapelthorpe

There were two reported crimes in Chaplethorpe, one of which was a burglary to a garage on Church Lane, the other being a domestic related incident.

Crigglestone

There were eight reported crimes in Crigglestone, two of which were serious and acquisitive crimes.

The first acquisitive crime relates to a burglary to a shed on Stoney Lane and the second relates to a theft from motor vehicle on Daw Green Avenue. No suspects have been identified.

There were six other crimes reported, three of which were damages, the others are not seen to impact on the community.

Durkar

There were five reported crimes in Durkar. Only one of which was classed as a serious acquisitive crime. This relates to a theft of Dumper Truck on the Wimpey Construction site.

Out of the other four crimes, none are seen to have an effect upon the community.

Hall Green

There were ten reported offences in Hall Green. One of these was an offence of damage, and two were serious and acquisitive crimes. These relate to Burglary of a shed on Moorside Crescent and the other an attempt burglary on High Keep Fold, no suspects identified.



Seven other crimes were reported are not seen to have had an impact on the community

Newmillerdam

There were two crimes reported in Newmillerdam, one of which was a theft from motor vehicle in the car park on Barnsley Rd. The other reported crime was a public order type offence.

Calder Grove
