Crimes:

Chapelthorpe

In Chapelthorpe there were three reported offences. The first was a burglary other than a dwelling at the Pennine Camphill Community where entry was gained by unknown means and property stolen. No suspects have been identified. The next crime was an attempted burglary dwelling at an address on Church Lane where the suspects have tried and failed to gain entry to the address by attacking the euro profile lock.

The other crime consisted of an assault at the Bay Horse Public House

Newmillerdam

In Newmillerdam there was one reported crime, which was a theft from the Hotel St Pierre.

Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there were fifteen reported crimes, including four serious acquisitive crimes. One of these was an attempted burglary dwelling at an address on Manor Farm Court where the suspect has smashed an outer pane of a double glazed window, but not gained entry and made off unseen. The second was a theft from a motor vehicle on Hasslegrave Park where the vehicle was insecure. No suspects have been identified. There were also two theft from motor vehicles on High Street where one was insecure and another a window was smashed. At this time no suspects have been identified.

Working in partnership to reduce crime

The other crime consisted of an arson (vehicle) on Painthorpe Terrace, a vehicle interference on the Crigglestone Industrial estate, a malicious communication on Mackie Road, a make off without payment at Calder Park Service Station, public order offences on Common Way, Fishponds Drive and Daw Green Avenue, an assault on New Hall Close, two damages on Daw Green Avenue and a damage on Common Way.

Hall Green

In Hall Green there were five reported offences, none of which were serious acquisitive.

The reported crimes were a public order offence at Dane Royd School, an assault on Moorland Drive, an assault on Russell Avenue and a possession of prohibited images of a child on the same street and a threat to cause damage on Copeworth Drive.

Durkar

In Durkar there were five reported crimes, one of which was a serious acquisitive crime. This was a burglary on Otters Holt where the suspects have gained entry by attacking a euro profile lock causing the alarm to sound, but still stealing property.

The other offences was a possession of a class b drug in a stopped vehicle (police initiated), two theft from shops on Denby Dale Road East, a damage on Peel Avenue and an assault on Fox Lane.

Calder Grove

In Calder Grove there were two reported crimes, one of which was a serious acquisitive crime. This was a burglary dwelling at and address on Grove Park where suspects have broken into the house using bodily force to steal keys to motorbikes. Suspects made off when an alarm went off. This is still under investigation.

The other crime was a theft at the Cedar Court Hotel.



Anti-Social Behaviour:

In Calder Grove there was one report from a resident on Denby Dale Road who had found some string tied around their fence post at the rear of their property. The caller was concerned that it was a signal for someone to steal their dog.

In Chapelthorpe there was one report of a suspicious incident on Church Lane where they believed that someone tried their door handle. They looked out of the window and saw someone getting into an old silver Volvo.

In Crigglestone there were three reports. There was one on High Street regarding a male seen going up driveways wearing a hi-vis vest. There was a report about nuisance youths on push scooters on Cotham Drive building ramps in the road. There was also a report of some suspicious males seen on the industrial estate that the caller believed were breaking into a vehicle, but police where on scene immediately and inspected the vehicle identified by the caller and there was no evidence of any offences at that time.

In Durkar there were three calls. One was in relation to speeding cards on Denby Dale Road, another relating to nuisance youths at KFC, and the third regarding a male on Kingfisher Close trying car door handles.

In Hall Green there was one report of nuisance youths throwing objects at a house on Moorside Crescent.

In Newmillerdam there was a report regarding lampers of Lodge Lane and a call regarding 15-20 vehicles parked on Barnsley Road causing an obstruction and forcing people to cross the double white lines in the centre of the road.
