## **Priority Patrols:**

HGVs on Hollin Lane and Durkar Lane.

Parking issues on Almshouse Lane, the King Fisher and most other roads.

Patrols around Betty Eastwood Park for the rough sleeper.

One Stop (High Street) after 2300 hours.

Speeding locations are Denby Dale Road, Durkar Low Lane and Fishponds Lane.

Patrols around the area regarding TFMV in the early hours.

## **Crimes:**

### **Hall Green**

In Hall Green there were five reported crimes. Of these four were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first of these was a theft from motor vehicle on Charles View where entry was gained by unknown means and property removed. The property was recovered by the owner from a nearby hedge.

There were two offences on Bailey Walk. The first was a theft from motor vehicle where the vehicle was left insecure and an iPod and cash were taken. The second was a burglary other than a dwelling where a shed door was forced and a bicycle stolen from within.

Lastly there was a burglary dwelling on Castle Meadows where the suspect gained entry to the property through an insecure conservatory window, removed keys to two vehicles and then searched the two vehicles stealing nothing and leaving the keys in the vehicles.

For all four of these offences a suspect has been arrested. The investigation is still ongoing.

The other crime consisted of a malicious communication on Micklethwaite Road.

### **Crigglestone**

In Crigglestone there were eleven reported crimes. Of these five were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

There was a burglary other than a dwelling on Aberfield Drive where the suspect has broken into a shed causing damage to the door, but no property was stolen.

There were also two theft from motor vehicles on Aberfield Drive where the suspect has gained entry by unknown means, stolen property (sunglasses and a USB memory stick), and made off unseen.

There was a burglary other than a dwelling on Woodmoor Drive where again the suspect has broken into a shed causing damage, but no property was stolen.

All four of these crimes occurred on the same night so it is believed that the same suspect is responsible.

There was a burglary at an address on Manor Farm Road where the suspect has gained entry through an insecure conservatory window. When inside the suspect has located and stolen vehicle keys. Upon exiting the property the suspect has activated the alarm alerting the occupants. A suspect has been arrested, but they have not been charged.

The other crimes consisted of an assault, a theft and a taking of a motor vehicle without the owner's consent on Daw Green Avenue, a theft from shop on High Street, a theft on Mackie Hill Close and a public order offence on Garden Terrace.

## **Durkar**

In Durkar there were twelve reported crimes. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a theft from motor vehicle at Mercedes, Peel Avenue where a spoiler was stolen from a vehicle. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified.

The second of these was a theft of motor vehicle from Julie Avenue where the owner believes that they dropped their keys on the driveway. The stolen vehicle, a Nissan Juke in white, has not been located at this time.

The other crimes consisted of an immigration offence (an illegal immigrant handing themselves in) at the Calder Park Services, a theft from shop on Denby Dale Road East, an assault on Denby Dale Road, two make off without payments from the Euro garage (Calder Park), three make off without payments from the Grange Service Station (Denby Dale Road), a taking of a motor vehicle without the owner's consent on Denby Dale Road (domestic related) and a malicious communication on Denby Dale Road.

## **Newmillerdam**

In Newmillerdam there were three reported crimes. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

Two vehicles (vans) were targeted whilst the owners were staying at a hotel, suspects gaining entry by smashing a window in one and attacking a sliding door on the other. Once the suspect/s has gained entry to the vehicles they stole power tools. All lines of enquiry have been completed and both crimes have been filed.

The other crime consisted of a threat to cause damage on Almshouse Lane.

## **Chapelthorpe**

In Chapelthorpe there were three reported crimes. Of these all were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

They were a burglary other than a dwelling, theft from motor vehicle and theft of motor vehicle from an address on Wood Lane where tools have been stolen from an insecure garage, items have been stolen from an insecure vehicle and another vehicle has then been stolen with keys. It is believed that the keys for the stolen vehicle, a VW Polo in black, were either in the vehicle itself, or in the other insecure vehicle. These crimes are still under investigation.

## **Calder Grove**

In Calder Grove there were three reported crimes. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary other than a dwelling on Hollin Lane where a shed was broken into, but no property stolen. No suspects have been linked to this crime and it has been filed.

The second was a burglary other than a dwelling at the British Oak public house (currently undergoing renovation) where suspect/s broke in through a window and have stolen power tools. The investigation is still ongoing.

The other crime consisted of a harassment on Sandpiper Road and an assault at the Cedar Court Hotel.

## **Anti-Social Behaviour:**

### **Calder Grove**

In Calder Grove there were three ASB related calls. The first was when an off-duty police officer found a hidden mini motorbike off Broadcut Road (Police attended and the bike was recovered), the second was when two males were seen looking up driveways on Hollin Lane and the third was regarding an off-road motor bike being ridden on the pavements on Blacker Lane.

### **Crigglestone**

In Crigglestone there were four ASB related calls. The first was a report regarding a regular nuisance vehicle on Painthorpe Lane, the second about a group of youths on Cliff Road knocking on windows

scaring people, and the third and fourth were about a male seen looking into cars on Woodmoor Drive. Police attended, but could not find the male.

### **Durkar**

In Durkar there were four ASB related calls. The first was a suspicious male seen on Denby Dale Road. Police attended and located the male and all was in order. The second was a suspicious male on Orchard Drive. Police attended and located the male and again all was in order. The third was a report of a suspicious silver van on Durkar Fields. Police stopped the van and it was involved in looking for a missing person which the police were already aware of. The last call was about nuisance vehicles behind The Red Kite.

### **Hall Green**

In Hall Green there was one call regarding nuisance youths shining a laser pen into an address on Russel Avenue.

There were no other ASB related calls.

### **Officer Activity:**

Safe scheme carried out between 1300hrs and 1600hrs on 07/02/17. Areas patrolled were Stoney Lane, Painthorpe Lane, Betty Eastwood Park, Daw Green Avenue and Mackie Hill Close/ Mackie Hill School. Several drivers were spoken to and warned about inappropriate parking on Mackie Hill Close. Residents on Mackie Hill Close were made aware of my presence in the area.

12/02/2017 between 1400 x 1600 & 2200 x 0000

Patrols made on off road motorbike. Patrols local wooded areas and fields with no issues.

The patrols were also conducted in company of several special constables in plain and marked vehicles. A high quantity of vehicles stopped in areas around Crigglestone, due to high reports of "boy racers" in area. 1 X s.59 warning issued to driver due to antisocial driving. 2 X VDRS notices issued to car drivers due to issues with vehicles.

Minimal vehicular activity in area (for both bikes and cars) however probably due to the fact the weather was particularly cold.

Attended report of drunk group heading away from Painthorpe Lane. Spoke with group. No issues. Advice given. Particular attention spent in and around Starbucks car park due to reports of boy racers. Lots of vehicle in area driving at speed. Assistance requested by myself for traffic and local units. 1 X s.59 issued. Boy racers dispersed upon police attendance.

Several mopeds stopped. No issues. All compliant and road legal.

Speed Enforcement 3hrs on Denby Dale Road.

#### PCSO 438 Reports:

28/02/2017 between 1700 x 2000

Areas looked at were Painthorpe Lane, Stoney Lane, Fishponds Lane, Almhouse Lane, Wood Lane, Fishponds Lane, High Street and Hollin Lane. There was no ASB or parking obstructions sighted.

#### PC 2534 reports:

28/02/2017 1700 x 1830

Speed Enforcement Conducted.

Denby Dale Road, Durkar Low Lane all heavy traffic and not suitable for pro laser at that time.

Conducted speed checks on Fishpond Lane, 2 x verbal Warnings for 35mph, slight rain and 2 x Traffic Offence Reports for speeds of 39 and 43mph.

No parking issues near Kingfisher Fisheries, but the speeder doing 43 reported that there are no issues with parking on Hollin Lane outside the school, complaining of double parking at peak times.

Additional patrols were also regularly conducted between the hours of 0000 x 0500 after the peak in attempted vehicle break ins. A few stops were conducted, but nothing of note. This was not paid for through the safe scheme, but through normal policing.
