Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were ASB use of vehicles, ASB in Betty Eastwood Park and speeding throughout the parish.

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There were two reported crimes in Calder Grove. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft of motor vehicle from Black Hall Farm Shop where a Ford Transit was stolen. All enquiries have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of a public order offence on Denby Dale Road.

Chapelthorpe

There was one reported crime in Chapelthorpe. It was not classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

The crime was a damage on Hall Lane.

Crigglestone

There were nineteen reported crimes in Crigglestone. Of these four were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first of these was an attempted burglary business at the WMC on High Street where a suspect has tried to gain entry, but failed. The suspect was identified, but the victim did not want to pursue the matter so it was filed.

The next was a burglary business at All Blacks where the suspect/s have gained entry to the clubhouse through the roof and stolen money. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified.

The next was a theft motor vehicle on St James Road where the suspect/s have damaged the lock to gain entry and stolen a tool box from within. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified.

The last was a theft of motor vehicle from Bretton Lane where the suspects have stolen a recovery vehicle. The vehicle was recovered by Police in South Yorkshire, but no suspects have been identified. The investigation is still ongoing.

The other crimes consisted of two vehicle interferences and a theft (other) on High Street, a vehicle interference on Common Way, an assault and two harassments and a threats to kill at an address on Swallow Way, a damage at a different address on Swallow Way and another on Haveroid Lane, a public order offence on Common Way, a malicious communication on Hollin Lane, assaults on Painthorpe Lane and Painthorpe Terrace and a malicious communication on Haveroid Way.

Durkar

There were three reported crimes in Durkar. Of these none were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The other crimes consisted of a criminal damage at Otters Holt, a theft from shop on Denby Dale Road East and an assault on Hollin Drive.

Hall Green

There were eight reported crimes in Hall Green. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first of these was a burglary business at the Community Centre on Painthorpe Lane where the suspect/s have jemmed the fire escape and gained entry, but stolen no property. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The last was a theft from motor vehicle on Hollingthorpe Road where the registration plates have been stolen. Some names were put forward, but there was insufficient evidence to link these to the offence so the crime has been filed.

The other crimes consisted of two criminal damages and a theft (other) on Painthorpe Lane, a damage on Hollingthorpe Grove, a public order offence on Russell Avenue and an assault at the Bay Horse Public House.

Newmillerdam There were no reported crimes in Newmillerdam.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Calder Grove

There was one ASB related call in Calder Grove which was regarding a vehicle being driven aggressively on Denby Dale Road.

Chapelthorpe There were no ASB related calls in Chapelthorpe.

Crigglestone

There were five ASB related calls in Crigglestone. These were mainly about fly tipping on Painthorpe Lane (X3) and Painthorpe Terrace, but there was also one call relating to nuisance phone calls from a Chinese marketing company on Hollin Lane.

Durkar

There were four ASB related calls in Durkar. There was one report regarding a nuisance mini quad being driven on Durkar Lane, one regarding nuisance youths knocking on doors and running away on Durkar Low Lane, youths throwing snowballs on Calder Close and fly tipping on Durkar Lane.

Hall Green There were no ASB related calls in Hall Green.

Newmillerdam There were no ASB related calls in Newmillerdam.
