Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were ASB use of vehicles, ASB in Betty Eastwood Park and speeding throughout the parish.

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There was no reported crime in Calder Grove.

Chapelthorpe

There was one reported crime in Chapelthorpe. This was a theft of plant pot on Boyne Hill.

Crigglestone

There were six reported crimes in Crigglestone none of which were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

They were an assault on Dennington Lane, an assault on High Street, a racially aggravated public order incident on Common Way, a public order incident on Painthorpe Lane, a theft of pedal cycle on Manor Farm Road, and a criminal damage on Haveroid Lane.

Durkar

There were five reported crime in Durkar. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary residential at an address on Denby Dale Road where the suspect knocked on the front door. The victim was in and did not answer so the suspect has gone to the rear of the property and snapped the euro profile lock. Whilst inside the suspect has stolen the victim's purse before being challenged by the victim and making off. The crime is still under investigation.

The second was an attempted theft from motor vehicle on Hollin Drive where a quarter light window from a Citroen Berlingo has been smashed. There were no positive lines of enquiry and the crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of a public order incident and a fraud at an address on Durkar Fields and a public order incident on Willow Garth.

Hall Green

There were twelve reported crimes in Hall Green. Two of these were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a theft of motor vehicle on Hollingthorpe Avenue where a Mitsubishi Shogun was stolen from the drive. All lines of enquiry have been completed to no gain and the crime has been filed.

The second was a theft from motor vehicle on Hollingthorpe Road where a quarter light window was removed from a motor home. There were no positive lines of enquiry so the crime has been filed.

The other crimes consisted of a malicious communication on Hollingthorpe Road, a public order incident, an assault, and a harassment on Copeworth Drive, a theft of parcel on Lowmoor Crescent, an assault and criminal damage on Stoney Lane, a malicious communication on Russell Avenue, and a theft of lead and a public order incident at Dane Royd School.

Newmillerdam

There were four reported crimes in Newmillerdam of which two were classed as serious acquisitive. These were both theft from motor vehicles.

The first happened at the country park car park where suspects have gained entry to a vehicle by unknown means and stolen a bank card and mobile phone. Enquiries into this crime are still ongoing.

The other occurred at an address on Barnsley Road where a large quantity of cash, a drill and a sat nav were stolen from an insecure vehicle. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other crime consisted of a public order incident on Almshouse Lane and a public order incident on Barnsley Road (near the lake).

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Calder Grove

There were two ASB reports in Calder Grove. The first was a report about a nuisance vehicle on Denby Dale Road where the occupants were throwing items out of the window as it was driving. The second was a report of two off road bikes off Blacker Lane

Chapelthorpe

There were no ASB related calls in Chapelthorpe.

Crigglestone

There were twelve ASB related calls in Crigglestone. There were reports of fly tipping on Haveroid Lane and Daw Lane, nuisance youths on Swallow Way kicking a fence, nuisance youths on High Street throwing plumbs, nuisance youths on Aberfield Drive throwing stones, four reports regarding nuisance bikes on the pitches/fields off Daw Lane, nuisance youths climbing on "all sorts of things" on Woodmoor Drive, nuisance youths climbing on a garage roof on Painthorpe Lane, and a group of youths in the grounds of Mackie Hill School.

Durkar

There were six ASB related calls in Durkar. There were three reports of fly tipping on Denby Dale Road, nuisance vehicles racing on Denby Dale Road, nuisance youths on Durkar Lane shouting and jumping in the road and a nuisance motor bike (monkey bike) on Denby Dale Road.

Hall Green

There were no ASB related calls in Hall Green.

Newmillerdam

There were two ASB related calls in Newmillerdam. The first was a report of fly tipping in the country park car park, and the second was about nuisance vehicles parked near the dam revving their engines.

Officer Activity:

PC Kurtovic reports: (Omitted from last month's report)

24/06/2017 between 0000 x 0200

All areas of Crigglesone / Durkar patrolled. 3 youths spoken to on Hollin Lane - no issues.

Business park patrolled as well as main routes around the Crigglestone area - no issues and no calls for service.

PCSO Kuritzin reports:

06/07/2017 between 2300 x 0100

Safe carried out between 2300hrs and 0100hrs on 06/07/17. Areas patrolled were the KFC/Starbucks car park off Peel Avenue nothing to note. The areas of Crigglestone and Hall Green were patrolled. There were no issues of note.

PC Steel reports:

12/07/2017 between ?

Patrols made of area by Op. Matrix as part of SAFE scheme on 12/07/2017. The usual areas were patrolled in relation to nuisance bikes with no issues. These were Betty Eastwood Park, Crigglestone Rugby Club and surrounding woods, and general area. I was stopped however by numerous people stating there had been an increase in nuisance mopeds. I therefore visited local known nominals. The only issue of note was a very well known male who lives in Crigglestone. In his yard he had a burgundy Jinlun Motorbike. The number plate had been altered to read incorrectly. I spoke to a neighbour who stated he believes he has seen the bike being ridden but couldn't state for sure. The bike is very distinctive as it is a "chopper" style bike. Intelligence report submitted.

I also attended at Painthorpe Lane area and reported 2 nominals for riding off road motorbikes around Crigglestone with no insurance.

PCSO Kuritzin reports:

16/07/2017 between 2300 x 0100

Safe scheme carried out between 2300hrs and 0100hrs on 16/07/17. Areas patrolled were the village of Crigglestone, Durkar and Hall Green. Particular attention was given to the KFC/Starbucks car on Peel Avenue for inappropriate drivers but none were sighted.
