Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were;

Denby Dale Rd – Boy races and HGV parking in bus stops

Painthorpe Lane Jnc Woodmoor Drive – parking opposite the junction causing cars to enter the bend on the opposite side of the road (I have emailed highways asking if any restrictions can be imposed)

Hall Green - Nuisance Bikes (usually late evening)

Speeding on Durkar Low Lane and Fishponds Drive – Visibility requested during rush hour

Crimes: A significant increase noted in crime across the parish including a rise in serious and acquisitive crimes.

Calder Grove

There was only 1 reported crime in Calder Grove which was a domestic related incident.

Chapelthorpe

There were two reported crimes in Chapelthorpe, one of which was a damage to motor vehicle on Hall Lane, no suspects have been identified.

Crigglestone

There were eighteen reported crimes in Crigglestone, four of which were serious and acquisitive crimes.

The first serious acquisitive crime relates to a 2 in 1 burglary on High Street where entry was gained a vehicle was taken. The second being an attempt burglary on the Willows where entry was attempted but not gained. The third being a theft from motor vehicle on blacker lane and the forth being an attempt theft from motor vehicle on high street. At this time no suspects have been identified for all the above crimes.

There were fourteen other crimes reported, five of which were damages, the others are not seen to impact on the community.

Durkar

There were sixteen reported crimes in Durkar. Four of which were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first being a theft from motor vehicle on Peel Avenue, the second being a burglary on Hollin Drive where computer equipment was taken. The third relates to a burglary of a shed on Durkar Low Lane where tools were stolen and the forth being a garage burglary on Fox Lane where tools were also taken. No suspects have been identified for any of the above offences.

Out of the other twelve crimes, two were damage and the rest are not seen to have had an effect upon the community.

Hall Green

There were seven reported offences in Hall Green. Two of these were offences of damage, and two were serious and acquisitive crimes. These relate to a theft from motor vehicle on Marshall Avenue where tools were taken and another theft from m/v on Painthorpe Lane where a wing mirror was stolen. No suspects identified at this time.

Three other crimes were reported are not seen to have had an impact on the community

Newmillerdam

There were two crimes reported in Newmillerdam, both of which were serious and acquisitive crimes.

The first being a theft of a Renault clio on school hill which is still outstanding and some alloys stolen from a vehicle on Almshouse Lane, no suspects identified for either.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Calder Grove

There were two ASB calls for Calder Grove, both relate to youths on Broadcut Rd in the canal and noise on Primrose Lane.

Chapelthorpe

There were no reported ASB calls in Chaplethorpe in July.

Crigglestone

There were six ASB calls in Crigglestone in July, they were as follows;

Youths starting fires on Church View.

Youths throwing bricks on the building site on Standbridge Lane.

Youths throwing stones on both Manor Farm Ct and Painthorpe Lane.

A youth being racially abusive towards a shop keeper on Painthorpe Lane.

Youths drinking and generally being rowdy on Daw Green Avenue.

Durkar

There were two reports of ASB in Durkar, both on Denby Dale Rd. The first being youths disrupting the traffic and the second being boy races along the road.

Hall Green

There were two ASB calls for Hall Green, one being a noise complaint on Painthorpe Lane and the second being a neighbour issue on Copeworth Drive.

Newmillerdam

There was one ASB call to the hotel on Barnsley rd where drunken guests were refusing to leave.
