

Priority Patrols:

Parking on Stoney Lane near the Co-op and on Wood Lane near the terraces houses.
Speeding on Fishponds Lane, Durkar Lane and Dennington Lane.
Parking on Hollin Lane obstructing the pavement.
Off road bikes and ASB at Painthorpe.
Parking on Broadacres.

Crimes:

Chapelthorpe

There have been no reports of serious acquisitive crime or other crimes in Chapelthorpe.

Calder Grove

In Calder Grove there was a vehicle interference on Branch Road where a window was smashed, but no property stolen.

The other reported crimes were a damage and two assaults.

Hall Green

There have been no reports of serious acquisitive crime in Hall Green. The other crime consists of two damages, two theft from shops, a public order offence, a harassment and a theft (other).

Durkar

In Durkar there was a vehicle interference, a burglary other (than a dwelling) and two burglary dwellings.

The first burglary dwelling occurred on Denby Dale Road. The victim and suspect are ex-partners and the suspect has gained entry with the intention of causing grievous bodily harm.

The second burglary dwelling occurred on Orchard Gardens where a BMW M135 was stolen. The car was later recovered in Bradford and three suspects identified.

The burglary other occurred on Howard Crescent where some tyres were stolen from an insecure shed.

The vehicle interference occurred at Premier Inn where the rear doors of a van were attacked, but no entry gained.

The other reported crimes were three make-off without payments, a theft from shop, a theft (other) and two public order offences.

Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there was a report of a vehicle interference on St James Way where the door on a van was bent back, but nothing stolen.

There was also a report of a robbery where the suspect was the child of the victim. The suspect assaulted the victim during an argument and stolen money.

The other crime consists of two assaults, a public order offence, possession of indecent images of a child, a damage, two harassments and a malicious communication.

Newmillerdam

There have been no reports of serious acquisitive crime in Newmillerdam. The other crime consists of a theft (other) and an arson that occurred in the woods.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

In Calder Grove there was a nuisance youths report from a resident on Blacker Lane where the kids were throwing stones off the viaduct.

In Crigglestone there were reports on Daw Green Avenue of nuisance kids throwing water balloons at a house, a report of an off road bike on the All Blacks fields, and a report of kids setting a fire in Betty Eastwood Park.

In Durkar there was a report of a male filming houses on his phone, but they have not been identified. There was also a report of two males walking along Durkar Lane that were holding leaflets, but not delivering them. The suspected that these males may have been sussing up the houses.

In Hall Green there was a report of a nuisance motor bike on Copeworth Drive. A Section 59 warning (for anti-social behaviour) was issued to the rider. There was also a nuisance bike driving on Mostyn Walk which was owned by one of the residents. NPT officers attended to deal.

In Newmillerdam there was also a report of a nuisance bike. This was on Barnsley Road and the bike had gone prior to police arrival.
