# **Priority Patrols:**

HGVs on Hollin Lane and Durkar Lane.

Parking issues on Almshouse Lane, the King Fisher and most other roads.

Patrols around Betty Eastwood Park.

Speeding and antisocial use of vehicles.

# **Crimes:**

#### Hall Green

There were six reported crimes in Hall Green of which one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was the taking of an Audi S5 without the owner's consent from an address on Cross Road. The suspect was identified, but the victim did not support a prosecution so no further action was taken.

The other crime consisted of a child neglect offence on Cross Road, a racially aggravated public order offence on Cross Road, a public order offence on Hollingthorpe Road, an assault of Russell Avenue and a theft in dwelling on Copeworth Drive.

### Crigglestone

There were eighteen reported crimes in Crigglestone of which three were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first of these was a theft from motor vehicle on Dennington Lane where suspect/s have broken into a van and stolen a dash cam. Enquiries are still ongoing.

There was then a report of a sneak in burglary residential at an address on 1 Swallow Way. The victim refused to cooperate with the police and the crime has been finalised.

The last of these was a theft from motor vehicle on High Street where a Ford Transit was broken into and tools and a laptop were stolen from within. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect has been identified.

The other crime consisted of three assaults on Garden Terrace, West View and Painthorpe Lane, four malicious communications on Painthorpe Lane, High Street and Daw Green Avenue (x2), two thefts on Fishponds Drive and West View, two public order offences on Hollin Lane, Common

Way, two theft in dwellings on Common Way and Hollin Lane, and a damage and a threat to commit damage on High Street.

#### Durkar

There were seven reported crimes in Durkar of which two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first of these was a theft of a Honda C90 motor bike on Denby Dale Road East. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The last was a theft from motor vehicle on Orchard Gardens where an insecure BMW has had items stolen from it. The items were recovered nearby and the investigation is still ongoing.

The other crime consisted of a make off without payment from Denby Grange Service Station, Denby Dale Road, three make off without payments and a public order offence at the Peel Services.

#### Newmillerdam

There were two reported crimes in Newmillerdam of which both were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary business and community at a hire company on Barnsley Road where suspects have been in by unknown means and then caused damage to and stolen items from vehicles parked therein.

The last was a theft from motor vehicle from the Country Park car park where a suspect has stolen a purse from a Ford Focus (no damage caused). All lines of enquiry are complete and no suspect/s have been identified.

### Chapelthorpe

There was no reported crime in Chapelthorpe.

## **Calder Grove**

There were three reported crimes in Calder Grove of which one was classed as serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft from motor vehicle a Cedar Court where tools were stolen from an insecure Ford Transit. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other offences consisted of a damage on Blacker Lane and a harassment on Hollin Lane.



# **Anti-Social Behaviour:**

### **Calder Grove**

In Calder grove there were seven ASB related calls. Of these two were about a "rave" making a lot of noise in the woods near Blacker Lane, two were about the travellers at Cedar Court, and three were about flytipping on Broadcut Road (x2) and Blacker Lane.

# Chapelthorpe

In Chapelthorpe there were four ASB related calls which were all about flytipping. There was one report about flytipping on Stoney Lane, one on Well Head Mews, and two on Wood Lane.

# Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there were twenty ASB related calls. There was a report about nuisance youths on Painthorpe Lane running about the street and shouting/screaming, a report about youths on the roof of a property on Fishponds Drive and two regarding the same on Swallow Way. There was one call about a noisy party on Bailey Walk, and two about a noisy party on the field behind Pipers Green. There were six reports about flytipping (four on Swallow Way, one on Daw Green Avenue, and one on Painthorpe Lane). There were then six reports about off-road bikes around Painthorpe Lane.

### Durkar

There were five ASB related calls in Durkar. These were one about some drunk males shouting in the street on Kenton Drive, one about youths throwing stones at vehicles on Denby Dale Road, and three regarding nuisance cars speeding on Denby Dale Road.

### Hall Green

In Hall Green there were two reports about nuisance bikes on Cross Road and Beech View.

## Newmillerdam

In Newmillerdam there was one ASB related call which was about flytipping on Barnsley Road.
