Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were Parking on Painthorpe Lane, Vehicles parking in the bus layby's on Denby Dale Road, Betty Eastwood Park - anti social behaviour youths and others on a summers evening etc, Speeding- Boy- racers on Denby Dale Road, inconsiderate parking all over the parish, HGV's over 7.5t limit illegally going down Durkar Lane usually from Torque distribution or Crigg ind estate.

Crimes: Large reduction noted in the recorded number of Serious acquisitive crimes.

Calder Grove

There were only 3 reported crimes in Calder Grove, all three being various other crimes that are not worthy of note.

Chapelthorpe

There were no reported crimes in Chaplethorpe in the month of June.

Crigglestone

There were ten reported crimes in Crigglestone. Of these only two was classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The serious acquisitive crimes relate to firstly the attempted burglary business of Top Treads on High Street, no suspects identified. Secondly the attempt burglary of a residential property where entry was not gained, again no suspects identified.

There were eight other crimes reported, none worthy of a mention.

Durkar

There were eight reported crimes in Durkar. None were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

There was a report of damage whereby a motor vehicle was damaged by unknown offenders on Denby Dale Rd after a car was scratched. Seven other crimes were reported, several were domestic and other were public order related.

Hall Green

There were five reported offences in Hall Green. Two of these were offences of damage, one being a windscreen on a car on Hollingthorpe Rd, the other being a hedge cut without the owners permission.

Three other crimes were reported but none worthy of a mention.

Newmillerdam

There were four crimes reported in Newmillerdam with only one being classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This relates to a burglary on Barnsley Rd where a pushbike was stolen from a greenhouse. The other three crimes were either of a domestic or public order nature.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Calder Grove

There were no ASB related calls for Calder Grove

Chapelthorpe

There was a report of nuisance motorcycles on Stoney Lane where they had been seen to be riding at speed and pulling wheelies.

Crigglestone

There was only one ASB call for Crigglestone where children were reported to be throwing stones on Daw Green Avenue, no damage caused.

Durkar

There was a report of nuisance vehicles on Denby Dale Rd where small cars were seen to be racing each other.

Hall Green

There was only one ASB related call in Hall Green, this relates to youths throwing alcohol around in a shop on Painthorpe Lane.

Newmillerdam

There were two ASB related calls for NMD, both on Barnsley rd, the first being children throwing stones and the other being parking issues.
