## **Priority Patrols:**

The priorities this month were ASB use of vehicles, ASB in Betty Eastwood Park and speeding throughout the parish.

## **Crimes:**

#### **Calder Grove**

There were two reported crimes in Calder Grove. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft from motor vehicle at Cedar Court where the suspect/s have forced entry to a van and stolen tools, a sat nav and dash cam. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of an attempted damage at Sandpiper Court.

## Chapelthorpe

There were four reported crimes in Chapelthorpe. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary business and community on Wood Lane where suspect/s have forced entry to an outbuilding and stolen power tools. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The last was a burglary residential on Boyne Hill where tools have been stolen from an insecure shed. No suspect/s have been identified and the crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of an assault on Stoney Lane with a snowball and an assault on Wood Lane.

#### Crigglestone

There were eight reported crimes in Crigglestone. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was an attempted burglary residential at an address on High Street where the suspect/s have tried to jemmy open a rear door without success. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other crime consisted of a damage at Woodmoor Rise, a damage at High Street, a malicious communication on Woodmoor Close, an assault on High Street, a malicious communication on Durkar Rise, and a threats to kill (domestic related via telephone) on High Street.

#### Durkar

There were three reported crimes in Durkar. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was an attempted burglary residential at an address on Durkar Low Lane where a suspect has tried to open a detached garage. They were disturbed by a neighbour and made off. CCTV images of the suspect have been circulated, but as of yet the suspect remains unidentified.

The other crime consisted of a public order offence at Willow Garth and an assault on Durkar Lane.

#### Hall Green

There were three reported crimes in Hall Green. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a burglary residential at an address on Hollingthorpe Road. The property was empty as the victim was in hospital. The suspect/s have forced entry and stolen medication, alcohol and a laptop. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified. The crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of a damage and two public order offences at Copeworth Drive.

#### Newmillerdam

There were three reported crimes in Newmillerdam. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was an attempt burglary business and community at La Fortezza where the suspect/s have attempted to jemmy open doors and windows without success. The crime has been filed.

The last was a burglary residential on School Hill where an insecure shed has been entered and tools stolen, but they were later discovered in a neighbour's garden. No suspect/s have been identified and the crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of an assault on Barnsley Road.

## **Anti-Social Behaviour:**

### **Calder Grove**

There was one ASB related calls in Calder Grove. It was about nuisance youths shining laser pens on St Johns Gardens.

## Chapelthorpe

No ASB calls.

## Crigglestone

There were four ASB related calls in Crigglestone. Two were about fly tipping on Daw Lane and Swallow Way. The other two were about nuisance youths on Garden Terrace throwing stones and on the industrial estate off High Street messing about.
