## **Priority Patrols:**

Parking on Stoney Lane near the Co-op and on Wood Lane near the terraces houses.  
Speeding on Durkar Low Lane, Hollin Lane and Denby Dale Road.  
Off-road bikes near Painthorpe,  
HGVs  
Parking on Broad Acres.

## **Crimes:**

### **Chapelthorpe**

There have been no reports of serious acquisitive crime in Chapelthorpe. The other crime consists of a theft (other).

### **Calder Grove**

There was a theft from motor vehicle at Cedar Court. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified at this stage.

Also in Calder Grove there has been an assault Police Officer, an assault and two theft (other).

### **Hall Green**

There have been no reports of serious acquisitive crime in Hall Green. The other crime consists of a public order offence, a fraud and an assault.

### **Durkar**

There was a burglary at Durkar Low Lane where suspects have gained entry via an insecure front door. At the time of reporting it is believed that nothing was stolen. The investigation is still ongoing.

Also in Durkar there have been four make off without payments, two theft (other), three assaults, and a theft from shop.

## **Crigglestone**

There was a theft from motor vehicle from St James Road. There were no lines of enquiry so the crime has been filed.

There was another on Dennington Lane where again all lines of enquiry have been completed but no suspects identified at this stage.

Also in Crigglestone there has been one theft (other), six assaults, one damage, one racially aggravated assault, a dangerous dog and a vehicle taken without the owner's consent.

## **Newmillerdam**

There was also a theft from motor vehicle at the car park at Newmillerdam where property was stolen through an open window. No suspects have been identified at this stage.

The other crime in Newmillerdam was a public order offence, a theft (other) and an assault.

## **Anti-Social Behaviour:**

In Calder grove there was a report of youths kicking the door of a derelict house. No descriptions were passed and the youths ran off while the caller was on the phone.

In Crigglestone there were two reports of nuisance youths on Daw Green Avenue and a suspicious motor vehicle on Garden Terrace. The caller reported that the car had been parked on the street for two hours with two males sat inside. When the caller went out the car drove off.

In Durkar there was a report of nuisance vehicles on Denby Dale Road. Police attended and the vehicles moved on.

In Hall Green there was a report of three males and a female walking along Hollingthorpe Court carrying clipboards that the caller thought suspicious. This turned out to be a local candidate for the recent local elections.

## **Officer Activity:**

PCSO 438 reports:

09/05/2016 between 1300 x 1600

Safe scheme carried out between 1300hrs and 1600hrs. Stoney Lane was patrolled around the Co-op there were no parking issues. The terraced houses were patrolled around Wood Lane. There were cars parked up on the road but there were no legal obstructions. I spoke with Mr Woodcock of 7 Wood Lane who complained about the parking situation on Wood Lane. I pointed out that there were no parking offences on the lane and advised him to write a written letter to Highways for parking restrictions to be put in place such as yellow lines. I explained to him that once these were in place the police could enforce them.

Safe scheme carried out between 1300hrs and 1600hrs on 10/05/16. Areas patrolled were Stoney Lane no parking issues around the Co-op. Wood Lane no parking issues around the terraced houses.
