Priority Patrols:

HGVs on Hollin Lane and Durkar Lane.

Parking issues on Almshouse Lane, the King Fisher and most other roads.

Patrols around Betty Eastwood Park.

Speeding and antisocial use of vehicles.

Patrols around the area regarding TFMV in the early hours.

Crimes:

Hall Green

There were seven reported crimes in Hall Green of which one was classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

This was a theft from motor vehicle on Copeworth Drive where the suspect has gained entry to the vehicle by unknown means and removed property. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified.

The other crime consisted of an online sexual exploitation offence, an assault on Micklethwaite Road, a public order offence on Moorland Drive, a harassment on Hollingthorpe Road, and two counter allegations of domestic assault on Copeworth Drive

Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there were fourteen reported crimes. Of these two were classed as a serious acquisitive crimes. The first was a theft from motor vehicle on Hollin Lane where the suspect has smashed a window and stolen tools. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect has been identified.

The second was a burglary at the One Stop Shop, High Street where a suspect has gained entry by damaging the grill and window and once inside has stolen thousands of pounds worth of cigarettes. A suspect has been arrested and charged.

The other crime consisted of a public order offence on Hollin Lane, two theft from shops on High Street, a damage on Painthorpe Lane, a harassment on Manor Crest, a damage on South View, a harassment on Woodmoor Drive and a damage on Hollin Lane, a damage on Swallow Way, a damage on Haveroid Lane, a dangerous driving on St James Way and a malicious communication on Daw Green Avenue.

Durkar

In Durkar there were eleven reported crimes of which one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a burglary business and a convenience store on Denby Dale Road East where the suspects have forced the shutters and stolen cigarettes. Arrests have been made and suspects charged.

The other crime consisted of a domestic related harassment on Denby Dale Road, a drugs offence on Julie Avenue, three make-off without payments from Grange Service Station on Denby Dale Road and two make-off withouts payment from the Euro Garage, Peel Avenue, a theft from shop on Denby Dale Road East, a common assault on Durkar Lane and a possession on drugs on Denby Dale Road near the motorway junction.

Newmillerdam

In Newmillerdam there were four reported crimes of which none were classed as serious acquisitive crime.

The other crime consisted of a public order offence at the park car park on Barnsley Road and a theft of the St Pierre Hotel, a criminal damage on Barnsley Road and an indecent exposure on School Hill (reported to the suspect's care worker by the victim).

Chapelthorpe

In Chapelthorpe there were two reported crimes. Neither were classed as a serious acquisitive crimes.

The crimes were a domestic assault on Stoney Lane and a damage on Hall Lane.

Calder Grove

In Calder Grove there was one reported crime. This was not classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

The crime was an assault on Rockwood Crescent.

There was one report of flytipping on Blacker Lane.

Chapelthorpe

No reports.

Crigglestone

There were five reports regarding nuisance motor bikes that were seen on Common Way, Swallow Way, Daw Lane, South View and Hollin Lane.

There were two reports of flytipping. These were on Painthorpe Lane and West View.

Durkar

There were three reports of nuisance cars racing, one on Peel Avenue and two on Squirrels Drey, and there was one report of a nuisance motorbike on Durkar Lane.

Hall Green

There was one report of a nuisance motor bike on Painthorpe Lane.

Newmillerdam

There was one report of a nuisance quad bike in the park off School Hill.

Officer Activity:

PC Steel reports:

30/04/2017 between 1200 x 1400 (not included in the April report)

Patrols of area on 30/04/2017 between 12:00 x 14:00. There has been a big increase in reports of bikes around Painthorpe Lane area. I spent a lot of time in and around that area including the woods and fields which draw the bikers to the area. 1 x off roader sighted which made off and was not located. Following this no more bikes appeared, and no reports for the area through rest of shift.

Whilst on patrol on High Street in Crigglestone several locals stopped me and stated the mopeds which caused a big problem last year have been riding around again. As a result I visited the two local nominals who are involved in the scooter activity. I spoke to parents of both males as they themselves weren't in. Both were police friendly and stated they will keep an eye out. There were no further sightings through overtime and during rest of my shifts. There were no other reported issues.

PCSO Kuritzin reports:

08/05/2017 between 1300 x 1600

Safe scheme carried out between 1300hrs and 1600hrs on 08/05/17. Areas patrolled were Stoney Lane, Fishponds Lane, Hollin Lane, Betty Eastwood Park and High Street. There was no ASB or parking obstructions found.

PCSO Kuritzin reports:

09/05/2017 between 1300 x 1600

Safe scheme carried out between 1300hrs and 1600hrs on 09/05/17 on foot patrol. Areas patrolled were Stoney Lane, Hollin Lane, Painthorpe Lane, Daw Green Avenue, Betty Eastwood Park and High Street. There was no ASB or parking obstructions.

PC Steel reports:

10/05/2017 between 1200 x 1400

Usual patrols made of woods/fields however a lot of time was spent on Daw Green area due to intel from PCSO McGuire regarding nuisance bikes. Whilst in area 2 X off road bikes were seen riding up and down the back streets. Both made off upon seeing me and were not located. I was able to pinpoint a cluster of houses where I believe the bikes were coming from and will liaise with PCSO McGuire to gather further intel with a view to visiting the nominals. I will be patrolling the area at the exact time tomorrow.

PC Steel reports:

11/05/2017 between 1200 x 1300 and 2300 x 0000

Patrols made of area between 12:00 X 13:00 and 23:00 x 00:00 on 11/05/2017. During evening patrols there were no issues in area. All of time spent in Painthorpe Lane area as information has been received regarding the use of illegal motorbikes around this time. There were no issues.

During the daytime patrols the only thing of note was a male sighted on Painthorpe Lane pushing an off road motorbike towards Daw Green. The male was stopped and was compliant. He stated he had taken the bike to his friends to repair and was pushing it home. I tested the bike and it did not start due to a mechanical problem, and the engine was cold so it had clearly not been ridden.

It was not the same bike that I had seen previously. It was easily identifiable however should any future calls come as it was a green off roader with a number 9 on the front.

PC Kurtovic reports:

09/05/2017 between 0000 x 0200

I worked two hours safe scheme on 9th May - 00x02

All areas of Crigglestone covered. Particular attention paid to churches, One Stop Shop on Denby Dale Road East and the business park at J39. A couple of cars parked up in lay by near CSI building - checked and in order.

PCSO McGuire reports:

2 hours safe scheme from 23hrs to 01hrs.

Patrolled CALDER PARK, HOLLIN LANE, HAVEROID LANE, HOLLINGTHORPE, WOODMOOR, BETTY EASTWOOD, WIMPY ESTATE, PAINTHORPE, and DURKAR LANE.

No call for service.

Painthorpe / Hall Green also patrolled with no issues.
