

Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were Nuisance vehicles on Denby Dale Rd, HGV's coming down Durkar Lane, Nuisance Quads and bikes Daw Lane/Hollingthorpe Lane and Nuisance parking Painthorpe Lane jnt Woodmoor Dr.

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There were two reported crimes in Calder Grove. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

The serious acquisitive crime relates to a theft of an Audi SQ5 car which was stolen from Rockwood Crescent.

The other crime consisted of a damage on Denby Dale Rd where unknown persons have thrown debris from the viaduct onto a car below.

Chapelthorpe

There were two reported crimes in Chapelthorpe. One being damage to lights on St James Church, Church Lane where unknown offenders have damaged some lighting on the church to enable them to commit further offences at an adjacent property. This resulted in the other crime being reported, theft of lead flashing at said property.

Crigglestone

There were seven reported crimes in Crigglestone. Of these only one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

The serious acquisitive crime relates to the theft of a scooter by unknown offenders on west view, the vehicle is still outstanding.

There were two damages reported to motor vehicles, one where a window was smashed on an unattended vehicle by unknown suspects on The Links and one where a scratch was caused to an unattended vehicle on Manor Farm.

There were four other crimes reported, none worthy of a mention.

Durkar

There were five reported crimes in Durkar. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

There was a theft from motor vehicle on Denby Dale Rd where the suspect/s have stolen the keys from a car forecourt and made off with the vehicle. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

There was also a theft from motor vehicle on Willowgarth where unknown offenders have stolen the wheel trims from a car.

There was a report of damage whereby a motor vehicle was damaged by unknown offenders on Hollin Drive. Two other crimes were reported that were of a domestic nature.

Hall Green

There were four reported offences in Hall Green. Of these one was classed as serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft from motor vehicle whereby entry was gained to a transit van on Stoney Lane and some tools were stolen, there are no suspects identified as yet.

There was a damage reported on Jubilee Street where a wing mirror was pulled from a parked vehicle, suspects are still outstanding.

Two other crimes were reported but none worthy of a mention.

Newmillerdam

There were two crimes reported in Newmillerdam. Both were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary residential to a green house in a rear garden at Barnsley Rd that contained a mountain bike that was stolen, the offender is still outstanding and the crime has been filed at this time.

The second was a burglary residential on Lake View which is a property under renovation. The owners are abroad and the victim is a workman who had tools stolen, no suspects have been identified.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Calder Grove

There was only one ASB related incident at Calder Grove which relates to some fly tipping on Denby Dale Rd.

Chapelthorpe

There were no ASB related calls in Chapelthorpe.

Crigglestone

There were five ASB related calls in Crigglestone. Two were regarding nuisance youths throwing stones on Daw Green Av and a large group in the village who looked like they were collecting firewood for a camp fire where they were drinking alcohol and being rowdy. There was also a report of a motorbike in the village that has removed its exhaust in order to be louder and generally be a nuisance to residents. Two other incidents relate to fly tipping, one on Painthorpe Lane and one on Common Way.

Durkar

There were no reports of ASB in Durkar during May

Hall Green

There were two ASB related calls in Hall Green, one being eggs thrown at an address on Copeworth Drive and the other being a Quad bike being driven erratically on Stoney Drive.

Newmillerdam

There was one ASB call for Newmillerdam which relates to nuisance bikes and quads on Barnsley Rd.
