Crimes:

Chapelthorpe

In Chapelthorpe there was one reported crime. This was an assault on Tanyard Fold.

Newmillerdam

In Newmillerdam there were four reported crimes.

Of these one was a theft from motor vehicle at the park where suspect/s have gained entry by smashing a window. No suspect/s have been identified for this offence.

Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there were twelve reported crimes.

Hall Green

In Hall Green there five reported crimes.

Of these one was a burglary on Hollingthorpe Road where the suspect/s have smashed a window to gain entry. The investigation into this offence is ongoing. There was also a theft from motor vehicle on Castle Meadows where the suspect/s have gained entry by unknown means.

The other crime consisted of a vehicle interference on Copeworth Drive, a criminal damage on Moorland Drive and a make off without payment on Marshall Avenue.

Durkar

In Durkar there were five reported crimes.

Of these one was a theft from motor vehicle that occurred on Durkar Lane where entry was gained by forcing the lock to the boot. No suspects have been identified at this time.

There were also reports of a vehicle interference on Howard Crescent, another on Otters Holt, a harassment at the Grange Service Station on Denby Dale Road and an attempted assault on Durkar Lane.

Calder Grove

In Calder Grove there were five reported crimes.

There were three reports of vehicle interference. One was at Cedar Court Hotel, Sandpiper Court and the other was at Denby Dale Road. There was also a report of a theft of a mobile phone at the Cedar Court Hotel and a public order offence on Rockwood Crescent.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

There was another report of a loud vehicle on High Street and a large group of youths on Painthorpe Lane possible buying drugs. There was another report about nuisance youths hanging around Starbucks. The caller believed that they were there to fight with others. In Hall Green there was a report of nuisance youths on scooters on Marshall Avenue.

Manor Farm Court there was a report of youths throwing mud at windows. On Painthorpe Lane there was a report of youths kicking at the shutters of the shops. On High Street there was a report of a drone causing a nuisance. There was also a report of people letting fireworks off on Garden Terrace.
