Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were ASB use of vehicles, ASB in Betty Eastwood Park and speeding throughout the parish.

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There were no reported offences in Calder Grove.

Chapelthorpe

There were two reported offences in Chapelthorpe in November. Of these both were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary residential at an address on Hall Lane where two vehicles were stolen. Two suspects from Leeds were arrested and the vehicles recovered by the police. The investigation is still ongoing.

The second was a burglary residential on Boyne Hill where suspects force entry through the front door, locate and remove a safe. The investigation is still ongoing.

Crigglestone

There were eleven reported offences in Crigglestone. Of these none were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The reported offences were a domestic related harassment and damage on Swallow Way, a dangerous dog on Haveroid Lane, a malicious communication and a criminal damage on Moor View, a harassment on the Industrial Estate, a malicious communication on Dennington Lane, two domestic related damage on Woodmoor Rise, a criminal damage on Hollin Lane and a threat to commit criminal damage on West View.

Durkar

There were twelve reported offences in Durkar. Of these none were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The reported offences were a domestic related harassment and four theft from shops on Denby Dale Road East, a criminal damage, a theft (other) and a public order offence and a vehicle interference on Denby Dale Road, a make-off without payment at the Grange Service Station and a damage to motor vehicle and another damage at Premier Inn.

Hall Green

In Hall Green there were ten reported crimes in November. Of these three were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary residential on Hollingthorpe Avenue where suspect/s have forced a patio door to gain entry to the house and also forced entry to a caravan at the address. Once inside they have stolen various garden tools. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified.

The second was a burglary residential on Lowmoor Crescent where suspect/s have gained entry to a shed and stolen a lawn mower. Again all lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The last was a domestic related burglary residential where the partner of the victim has broken into their house and stolen a mobile phone. The investigation is currently still ongoing.

The other reported offences were two domestic related assaults at two addresses on Copeworth Drive, an assault, a domestic related damage and a theft from person on Painthorpe, a criminal damage on Hollingthorpe Road, and a public order offence on Copeworth Drive.

Newmillerdam

There were six reported offences in Newmillerdam. Of these three were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first two were a burglary residential and theft from motor vehicle on Almshouse Lane.

The facts of the burglary were that suspect/s have broken into outbuildings at an address but stolen nothing. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The facts of the theft from motor vehicle are that the suspect has broken into the boot of the vehicle and removed property. A male from Hall Green has been arrested and charged with the offence.

The last was an attempted burglary residential on Mill Farm Drive where unknown suspect/s have tried to force entry to a garage. They have been unsuccessful and have made off from the scene. All enquiries have been completed and the crime has been finalised.

The other reported offences were an assault between neighbours on Almshouse Lane, a dangerous dog at the country park and a public order offence on Barnsley Road.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Calder Grove

There were two ASB related calls in Calder Grove. One was about fly tipping on Rockwood Crescent and the other was about nuisance vehicle driving at excessive speed on Denby Dale Road.

Chapelthorpe

There were no ASB related calls in Chapelthorpe.

Crigglestone

There were three ASB related calls in Crigglestone. These consisted of reports of fly tipping on South View and High Street and a report of nuisance youths setting off fireworks on Bretton Lane making it dangerous for road users (N.B this was on bonfire night).

Durkar

There were five ASB related calls in Durkar. These consisted of report about a nuisance vehicle on Denby Dale Road where the occupants were shouting at other motorists, two reports about nuisance vehicles racing on Denby Dale Road, people throwing fireworks from a beer garden on Denby Dale Road and nuisance youths at Peel Services.

Hall Green

There was one ASB related call in Hall Green. This was a report of two nuisance youths climbing on residents' walls and bins.

Newmillerdam

There were four ASB related calls in Newmillerdam. These were a report about people having a bonfire and setting off fireworks in the park off School Hill, a report of fireworks being thrown at passing vehicles on Boyne Hill, a report about graffiti on Slack Lane and a report about fly tipping on Lodge Lane.

Officer Activity:

PCSO 438 Kuritzin reports:

02/11/17 and 03/11/17 between 2300 x 0100

Safe scheme carried out on 2/11/17 and 3/11/17 between 2300hrs and 0100hrs. Areas patrolled were the KFC / Starbucks car park off Peel Avenue. A PNC check was carried out on a vehicle that looked to be abandoned on Peel Avenue which came back uninsured no MOT, no tax and previous keeper details only. A roads policing intel report has been submitted. There was no inappropriate driving around the area on either night. The villages of Crigglestone, Hall Green and Chaplethorpe were patrolled all main roads and some side streets. There was no ASB, parking obstructions or crimes sighted.

PCSO 996 McGuire reports:

07/11/17 between 2000 x 2300

Areas patrolled are:

Calder Park, Durkar Fields, Wimpy housing estate, Painthorpe, Hall Green, Betty Eastwood, Daw Lane and Hollin Lane. There was one call for service which was about an abandoned insecure vehicle.

PCSO 996 McGuire reports:

16/11/17 between 2300 x 0200

Patrolled all areas. Betty Eastwood Park, Wimpy estate, Dennington Lane, High Street One Stop Shop, local schools, Calder Park and Hollin Lane. There were no issues.

PC 1845 Blore reports:

21/11 17 between 0000 x 0300

Mobile patrol carried out on 21/11/2017 between the hours of midnight and 03:00 by 1845/6251. Two males were stop searched at 01.00 approx. They were seen by residents going in and out of driveways on Durkar Low lane, Wakefield. They were stopped nearby and searched. Nothing was found. Also attended report of suspicious circumstances in Newmillerdam were someone may have been trying to gain entry to house. An area search was carried out and occupants spoken to. There was no evidence of attempt break in.

PCSO 438 Kuritzin reports:

23/11/17 between 2300 x 0100

Safe scheme carried out between 2300hrs and 0100hrs on 23/11/17. Areas patrolled were the KFC/Starbucks car park off Peel Avenue where there was no inappropriate driving witnessed. The areas of Crigglestone, Chapelthorpe and Hall Green were patrolled throughout. A Police Warning notice was issued to a Nissan Quasqui on Bull Lane Junction with Standbridge Lane for obstruction.

PC 6487 Steel reports:

27/11/17 between 2200 x 0000

Patrols made of Crigglestone in car between 22:00 X 00:00 on 27/11/2017. Patrolled retail area with no issues at all. High Street and Painthorpe Lane generally quiet. One group of youths moved on from Painthorpe Lane due to loud noise but no major problems.

PC 6487 Steel reports:

28/11/17 between 1230 x 1530

Patrols made of area on 28/11/2017 between 12:30 X 15:30hrs on off road motorbike. Local woods patrolled with no problems. The field at rear of rugby club has fresh tyre tracks on it which looked to have been caused by a single bike. No signs of any bike activity in any other area.

Report of suspicious males in Newmillerdam car park I located 2 X males who were searched due to smell of cannabis. Nothing found and NFA.

Traffic patrols conducted. 1 X TOR issued for using mobile whilst driving. Parking around school closing was fine. One small girl caused cars to brake suddenly due to manner of crossing. Spoken to and advised regarding road safety. No other problems.
