## **Crimes:**

## Chapelthorpe

In Chapelthorpe there was one reported crime, which was a public order offence on Wood Lane.

#### Newmillerdam

In Newmillerdam there were no reported crimes.

#### Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there were thirteen reported crimes. Of these three were priority crimes.

The first was an attempt theft from motor vehicle on Durkar Lane where the suspects have bent back the door, but have not stolen anything. No suspects have been identified at this time.

The second was an attempt burglary on Fishponds Drive where one suspect has acted as a distraction by knocking on the front door while the other suspects have tried and failed to break into the garage. The investigation is still ongoing.

The third was another burglary on Fishponds Drive where the suspect have entered an annex through an unlocked door and stolen property. The investigation is still ongoing.

The other crimes consisted of a damage on Cliff Road, an assault on Calder View, an assault on Painthorpe Lane, a theft from shop on Denby Dale Road East, a theft on Painthorpe Lane, an assault on Painthorpe Terrace, a theft from shop on High Street, and three assaults on West View (one incident).

#### Hall Green

In Hall Green there was one reported crime, which was a theft from shop on Stoney Lane.

#### Durkar

In Durkar there were five reported crimes. Of these two were priority crimes namely a theft from motor vehicle and an attempted burglary dwelling.

The theft from motor vehicle occurred on Broadacres where the suspect/s has gained entry by unknown means and removed property. All the available lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The attempt burglary occurred on The Close where the suspects have attempted to snap the lock. They have been unsuccessful and have made off without gaining entry.

The other crimes consisted of a make-off without payment from the petrol station on Denby Dale Road, a theft by employee at Mercedes Benz and a malicious communications on Denby Dale Road.

## **Calder Grove**

In Calder Grove there were seven reported crimes of which two were priority crimes. The first was a theft from motor vehicle at Cedar Court where the suspect/s have bent the door back on a vehicle and stolen property. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The second was a burglary other than a dwelling also at Cedar Court where suspect/s have forced open a bedroom window and stolen property. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The other crimes consisted of a damage on Denby Dale Road, a damage at Cedar Court, a damage on Blacker Lane and two assaults at Delta Force Paintball Centre.
