# **Priority Patrols:**

The priorities this month were ASB use of vehicles, ASB in Betty Eastwood Park and speeding throughout the parish.

# **Crimes:**

#### **Calder Grove**

There were eight reported crimes in Calder Grove. Of these three were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

There was an attempt burglary residential and a burglary residential at neighbouring houses on Blacker Lane. For the former the suspects have tried to gain entry through an open window in the conservatory, but failed. For the latter the suspects have forced a downstairs window and when inside have stolen cash and jewellery. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspects have been identified at this stage.

The last was a theft of motor vehicle on Hollin Lane. The vehicle in question was a Mitsubishi Shogun. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of a theft in dwelling on Milton Close, two theft from shops at Blacker Hall Farm, a public order incident at Cedar Court and a damage on Hollin Lane.

#### Chapelthorpe

There were no reported crimes in Chapelthorpe.

## Crigglestone

There were sixteen reported crimes in Crigglestone. Two of these were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first of these was a burglary residential at an address on Bull Lane where the suspect/s have gained entry by forcing a window. Once inside an untidy search has been conducted, but no property stolen. At this stage no suspect/s have been identified.

The second was a burglary business on Crigglestone Industrial Estate where suspect/s have broken into a compound, damaged several vehicles and stolen another. The crime is still under investigation.

The other offences consisted of four assaults and a damage at Mackie Hill School, an assault on Woodmoor Drive, a dangerous dog on Haveroid Lane, an assault on Garden Terrace, a theft (other) on Daw Green Avenue, an attempted pick pocketing on the bus on Haveroid Lane, a theft

from shop on High Street, a damage on Painthorpe Lane and public order incidents on Daw Green Avenue and West View.

#### Durkar

There were nine reported crimes in Durkar. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a burglary residential at The Close where the suspect/s have gained entry by attacking the euro profile lock before stealing cash and jewellery. Enquiries are still ongoing into this offence.

The second was a theft from motor vehicle on Denby Dale Road East where the suspect/s have damaged the door of the vehicle to get in. Once inside they have stolen power tools. All lines of enquiry have been completed and this crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of two theft from shop on Denby Dale Road East, two make-off without payments from the Grange Service Station, a public order offence at The Close, a damage to motor vehicle and a drugs possession on Denby Dale Road.

#### Hall Green

There were ten reported crimes in Hall Green. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a vehicle interference on Stoney Lane where the suspect/s have attacked the lock causing damage, but failed to get in. The crime has been filed.

The second was an attempted burglary residential on Stoney Lane where the suspect has tried to force entry, but been disturbed by neighbours and made off. The suspect has not been identified and the crime has been filed.

The other offences consisted of two malicious communications and two public order incidents at addresses on Copeworth Drive, an assault at Dane Royd School, two assaults on Copeworth Drive and a theft from shop on Stoney Lane.

#### Newmillerdam

There were four offences reported in Newmillerdam. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft from motor vehicle on School Hill where entry was gained by unknown means and a saw and sat nav were taken. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other offences consisted of a public order incident on Wood Lane, a damage to motor vehicle on Slack Lane and a damage at the Hotel St Pierre.

# **Anti-Social Behaviour:**

### **Calder Grove**

There were no ASB related calls in Calder Grove.

# Chapelthorpe

There were two ASB related calls in Chapelthorpe both made from the same address Well Head Mews. They were made over two nights and were about loud music. This was passed to the council.

# Crigglestone

In Crigglestone there were eight ASB related calls. These were about nuisance youths on Manor Farm Road knocking on doors and running away, youths jumping in and out of people's gardens on Painthorpe Lane, nuisance motorbikes on High Street and Common Way, dog poo being thrown at a door on Painthorpe Lane, fly tipping on Daw Green Avenue and youths rattling a garden gate and throwing stones at address on Swallow Way and Common Way.

### Durkar

In Durkar there were three related ASB calls. One was about youths playing football on Willow Garth, the second was about nuisance youths at Burger King and the third was about boy racers at Premier Inn.

## **Hall Green**

There were two ASB related calls in Hall Green. The first was about youths trespassing on a field off Hollingthorpe Lane and the second was about parents parking on the junction with Hollingthorpe Road and Stoney Lane causing an obstruction.

## Newmillerdam

There were two ASB related calls in Newmillerdam. The first was regarding nuisance youths on Slack Lane pressing the caller's buzzer and knocking the bins over, and the second was about boy racers in the country park carpark.

# **Officer Activity:**

PCSO 438 Kuritzin reports:

Safe scheme carried out between 2300hrs and 0100hrs on 03/09/17 and 04/09/17.

Areas patrolled were:

KFC/Burger King/Starbucks car park on Peel Avenue. No sec 59s issued.
