Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were (CARRIED OVER FROM LAST MONTH);

- 1) Boy racers Denby Dale Rd near to KFC
- 2) Parking on Painthorpe Lane Jnc Woodmore Grove
- 3) HGV's coming down the hill on Durkar Lane
- 4) HGV parking in bus stops on Denby Dale Rd.
- 5) Footpath parking on Broad Acres.
- 6) Betty Eastwood Park arson and damage in an evening

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There were 2 reported crimes in Calder Grove in November, one being a public order type incident involving an argument in the street, the other a domestic related threats.

Chapelthorpe

There were no reported crimes in Chaplethorpe in the month of November.

Crigglestone

There were eight reported crimes in Crigglestone;

- There were two reported burglaries, one on Dennington Lane where a garage was attacked and several low value items were taken. The other burglary relates to a house on Painthorpe Lane where entry was gained through a garage window and some jewellery was taken. The offenders used a dark blue VW Golf to make good their escape.
- On the 2nd November, a triumph motorcycle was parked up on Julie Avenue when an unknown offender has approached the bike and they have removed parts from it.
- The other five reported crimes relate to domestic related harassments.

Durkar

There were nine reported crimes in Durkar;

- On the 12th November, the one stop shop on Denby Dale Rd East was attacked when a male has entered the store by forcing a door and he has attempted to gain entry to the cash machine. He has made off but located nearby by officers and arrested and charged for the offence.
- On the 23rd November, a lock was forced on a works van parked at the Premier Inn and an industrial vacuum cleaner was stolen.
- On the 12th November, an unattended car was scratched by an unknown offender on Hollin Drive.

Hall Green

Hall Green had eleven reported crimes in November;

- On the 3rd November, the convenience store on Painthorpe Lane was broken into and £7000 worth of cash and cigarettes were stolen.
- On the 13th November, a lock was damaged on a works van on Castle Meadows but no entry was gained.
- On the 10th November, windows on a property on Copeworth Drive have been smashed but it is believed this property was wrongly targeted by an offender thought to be seeking retribution for an earlier incident.
- The other eight crimes reported were four assaults, two harassments and two public order incidents. A majority of these were domestic related.

Newmillerdam

There were four reported crimes in Newmillewdam in November;

- On the 16th November, a property on Ashton Court was targeted and the offender forced a window, entered and stole a handbag.
- On the 2nd November a bicycle was damaged in a garden outside Lake View Flats, no suspects have been identified.
- The other two crimes reported relate to a assaults, one of which was domestic related.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Crigglestone

There were three reported ASB related incidents in the Crigglestone area in November. Only one call for Betty Eastwood Park as the dark and cold evenings assist us. No damage reported on this occasion. Fireworks were seen to be thrown from an unidentified moving vehicle on Standbridge Lane but no injuries were caused and an area search resulted in no offenders being located. Finally on Daw Green Avenue, a group of young children reported to be playing knock a door run.

Hall Green

There has been four ASB related calls to Hall Green. Two calls for Painthorpe Lane, one being youths playing loud music and being abusive to other members of the public and also youths smoking cannabis. The other two were for Edgemoor Rd where youths were seen throwing fireworks and also nuisance vehicles revving engines and wheel spinning.

Newmillerdam

Only one ASB related call for NMD, a report of youths starting fires on Slack Lane again.

Officer Activity:

PC 1845 Blore reports 01/12/2018

High visibility patrols carried out between 15:00 x19:30

Attention paid to Betty Eastwood park but due to darker night no youths present .

Patrolled Calder Island petrol station for reassurance to staff all spoken to no issues other than nuisance vehicles.

Bus stop on Denby Dale Road clear from lorries.

All estates patrolled and nothing of note to report.

PC 2639 REPORTS - Safe scheme high visibility patrol conducted between 1500x1900hrs on 5/11/18 working with PC 1845 BLORE paying particular attention for ASB calls for service re: fireworks & bonfires - no such calls for service whilst there & very few people on the streets.

Targetted foot patrols in Betty Eastwood Park, following concerns raised by Parish Council - no youths present. Patrols on Calder Park with no sign of ASB. Denby Dale Rd had heavy traffic so no issues with HGV's.

T/PS2819 Brumby reports;

Safe Scheme patrols performed 1900x2200 5th November. High visibility patrols performed in the parish with groups of youths regularly engaged with due to bonfire night. No concerns or issues around their intentions with most making their way home.

Betty Eastwood Park patrolled on foot twice through the tour where no persons were found inside.

Denby Dale Rd patrolled and none of the usual suspects found to be present. No acts of anti social driving witnessed. No HGV's found to be parking in the area.

Parking issues were not addressed due to the time of night but when the specific areas were patrolled, nothing untoward was seen.

PC 1845 REPORTS - Safe scheme high visibility patrol conducted between 1500x1900hrs on 12/11/18 paying particular attention for ASB calls for service - very few people on the streets.

Targetted foot patrols in Betty Eastwood Park, following concerns raised by Parish Council - no youths present. Patrols on Calder Park with no sign of ASB. Denby Dale Rd with no issues with HGV's. All Estate's in the Parish covered with no sign of youths nor any ASB - no calls for service.

PC 97 Howson RPU T3 reports:

Safe scheme overtime worked 1130x1300 26/11/2018, Crigglestone Ward.

Pro laser device deployed on Denby Dale road. 1x TOR issued for Exceed 30 (recorded speed at 40), verbal warning issued to 2x drivers. Log 761 relates to motor vehicle being abandoned on Denby Dale Road following sighting By Police. Vehicle is on false plates and subsequently recovered. Keeper enquiries requested.

Safe scheme patrols carried out 1900 x 2200 27/11/2018

Parking Issue highlighted by Cllr Plattern outside 67 Hollingthorpe Rd, Hall Green. Works van blocking the pavement. Owner spoken to and he advised it had broken down but he assured me that it was to be recovered on thursday.

Betty Eastwood park checked, no persons present. Denby Dale Rd checked for boy racers. Several young drivers spoken to in the car park and advised about loud music and potential antisocial driving. No HGV's seen parking in the bus stops.
