Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were;

- 1) Anti social behaviour on Denby Dale Road East, the side where the old Post Office was.
- 2) Parking on the bend on Painthorpe Lane and Woodmoor Drive.
- 3) Vehicles parking in the bus layby on Denby Dale Road
- 4) Boy- racers on Denby Dale Road.
- 5) Anti-social behaviour and criminal damage in Betty Eastwood Park. Recent fires (101 report logged for this) and vandalism to the picnic benches and other benches in the form of burning and scalping with some form of blade.

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There were 7 reported crimes in Calder Grove, three were residential burglaries, one on Sandpiper Rd (again) where the lock was snapped and a vehicle stolen. Then two on Grove Park, both attempts as the offender was disturbed trying to break into the properties. The other four were domestic related incidents and malicious communications.

Chapelthorpe

There have been no reported crimes in September.

Crigglestone

There were fifteen reported crimes in Crigglestone, these consisted of three residential burglaries, Cliff Drive and West View (both attempts) and High Street where a vehicle was stolen once entry had been gained. Two commercial burglaries, one at the Station Hotel, Bretton lane where slot machines were attacked and the other at Mackie Hill Junior School, Painthorpe Lane where a search was made but nothing stolen.

There was a theft of motor vehicle on Hollin Lane where some plant machinery was stolen and two damages, one being graffiti on the Industrial Estate and the other being the damage to picnic tables and bird boxes in Betty Eastwood Park.

The other 7 crimes relate to domestic and public order incidents.

Durkar

There were four reported crimes in Durkar and all related to domestic incidents.

Hall Green

Hall Green had 8 reported crimes, three Residential Burglaries, two on Stoney Lane where attempts were made but no entry gained and one on Castle Meadows where a patio door was

smashed and two vehicles stolen. There was also a commercial burglary at the Crigglestone Sports Club on Painthorpe Lane. There was a theft of a Ford Transit on Copeworth Drive with the vehicle still outstanding. The three other crimes relate to domestic incidents and a serious assault where the victim was stabbed, the offender was arrested.

Newmillerdam

There were three crimes reported in Newmillerdam, one of which was a theft from motor vehicle in the car park of La Fortezza on Barnsley Rd. The other two reported crimes were minor offences not thought to be impactive on the community.
