Priority Patrols:

The priorities this month were;

- Boy racers Denby Dale Rd near to KFC
- HGV parking Denby Dale Rd (bus stops)
- Footpath parking on Broad Acres, Durkar
- Youths in Betty Eastwood Park, Crigglestone
- Speeding on Stoney Lane

Crimes:

Calder Grove

There were five reported crimes in Calder Grove in December. There was a theft of m/v on the 3rd December where a VW Golf was taken without keys from Blacker Hall Farm Shop on Branch Rd, the vehicle is still outstanding. On the 1st Dec on Post office Rd, an unknown person jumped on the victim's car bonnet but made off unseen and on the 30th Dec on Denby Dale Rd a VW Polo was scratched but again the offender was not seen. The fifth and final crime being a rare Blackmail at the Cedar Court Hotel.

Chapelthorpe

There were two reported crimes in Chaplethorpe for the month of December. The first being a theft from m/v on the 4th Dec outside 5 Church Ln where an insecure van was searched but luckily nothing taken. The other crime being a Burglary residential at 6 Hall Lane where a set of car keys were taken and an Audi A3 was taken, the vehicle is still outstanding.

Crigglestone

There were eleven reported crimes in Crigglestone in December. The first being a burglary at Singh and Booze on Painthorpe lane where cigarettes and alcohol was taken. There were 4 further burglary residentials, three of which were all in the same evening on the 27th. 5 Daw lane where a shed was attacked and a moped stolen, 32 Dennington Lane where another outbuilding was attacked but nothing taken and another at 50 High St where the offender snapped the lock to the rear door and a handbag was stolen containing a purse. The handbag was discarded in a neighbour's garden but the purse had been removed. There was one further burglary at 154 Hollin Drive where a mountain bike was stolen from a shed on the 29th. There was a van attacked outside the working mens club on the High St on the 4th and a number of high value tools were stolen. A damage to a window was recorded on the 6th at 8 Daw Green Av and 4 other crimes were also recorded, a public order, a child protection and two harassments.

Durkar

There were eight reported crimes in Durkar in December, four of which were burglaries. One at Minster Law, Peel avenue on the 7th where offenders tried to jimmy open a door but failed and a shed burglary on the 27th at 102 Howard Crescent where alcohol was taken. The other two occurring on new years eve, both on Denby Dale Rd, both had locks snapped in patio doors which resulted in personal possessions being taken and also a vehicle which was later recovered. There was a vehicle interference on the 7th on Denby Dale Rd where a male was seen trying car door

handles but an area search proved negative. The other three crimes were either public order or nuisance phone call related crimes.

Hall Green

There were three reported crimes in Hall Green but all were domestic related, one a nuisance telephone calls, one a theft and the other an assault.

Newmillerdam

There were no reported crimes in Newmillewdam in December.

Anti-Social Behaviour:

Crigglestone

There were three reported ASB related incidents in the Crigglestone area in December. Two nuisance youth type incidents both on Daw Green Avenue where residents seem to be having issues with one particular family. The reports indicated that people were banging on windows and making a general nuisance of themselves. The other being a nuisance vehicle revving its engine loudly on Swallow Way.

Hall Green

There were no reports of ASB made in the Hall Green area in December.

Newmillerdam

Only one ASB related call for NMD, a report of youths playing loud music just off Barnsley Rd.

Calder Grove

There was one report of ASB in Calder Grove, this relates to an abandoned vehicle on Denby Dale Rd which was said to be causing an obstruction, it was later removed by the owner.

Chaplethorpe

There were no reports of ASB made in the Chaplethorpe area in December.

Durkar

Only one reported in Durkar, this being boy racers again on Denby Dale Rd. Just to note that this issue has now been highlighted as a problem solving task for the NPT so hopefully this issue will be targeted more in the coming months.

All Estate's in the Parish covered with no sign of youths nor any ASB - no calls for service.
