Working in partnership to reduce crime

Good Evening, Apologies for NO report during May. I had some time off over the back end of May therefore not able to complete the report. I have completed the figures above relating to May's monthly report so you have it for comparison.

During May/June there were several burglaries (10) around Cliff Road and Hollin Lane, PCSO Sykes and I attended to the area and identified a vehicle/suspect used in the crime, I've arrested the person in question who was in Barnsley and searched his properties (2) and located ALL property stolen – a total of 50 gardening items/power tools. During this time, NPT Rural were in the area on the evening searching for the van to ensure it did not return. (came back three times April/May)

I've also had complaints from All Black rugby grounds around Nuisance/ASB/Damage happening at the location. This has cost they thousand of pounds worth of damage. I've had 2 children identified for climbing on the roof and visited them and gave them and their parents words of advice as no offences identified. I'll be completing further patrols throughout the next month/summer holidays.

Also a member of the community has complained to MP Simon Lightwood about the speeding on Denby Dale Road, next to Kingfisher Chippie, If you're happy for this, the traffic officer will do some speed enforcement there over the next couple of weeks.

I spoke with the owners of Kings Takeaway - a lot of new nuisances has started due to the takeaway opening - they didn't provide much information or reason for the increase nor did they appear too interested in supporting any deterrent. community state that the owners know some of the new nuisance people, however they deny it. Visits to the area will increase due to the recent activity around Daw Green.

All Blacks Rugby - There have also been several issues around All Blacks which result in nuisance and damage etc costing the club over £10k to resolve over a period of time. This is surrounding, flood lights damage, roof tile damage, damage to the pitch etc. Visited the area several times but no one seen or present.

Other locations attended but appeared to be no issues throughout, vehicle checks completed around Calder Services and surrounding area but all checks ok and no issues.
